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Promoting Youth Exchanges in Europe

Nearly 200 towns took part in 1967 in the Council of Europe's development plan for intermunicipal exchanges. The aim of the plan is to promote exchanges of groups of young people between paired towns in different countries as a contribution to greater European unity. In this way 10,500 children and adolescents went on tours to sister towns abroad in 1967.

To encourage local authorities which make a special effort to arrange such visits for their young people, the Council of Europe awards each year a number of small grants. The list of merit, given below, of the towns chosen in 1967 has just been published by the Selection Board⁽¹⁾.
