Introduction

The present document provides information on the state of implementation of specific task iii. of the <u>Terms of reference</u> of the European Committee on Democracy and Governance (CDDG) for the biennium 2020-2021.

For the implementation of this specific task, a working group on accountability (GT-RE) has been set up. A <u>restricted webspace</u> has been set up to ensure that all CDDG members can have access to the working documents of the working group and contribute to its activities remotely. All publications can be found there, including additional documents such as the presentations by experts, current research studies and contributions made available by the member States themselves.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the workplan of GT-RE had to be adapted to take into consideration changes of working methods (with the organisation of videoconference meetings) and to the schedule.

The preparation of a draft recommendation is under way. The GT-RE held its first meeting on 13-14 February 2020, which involved: - A tour de table on accountability mechanisms concerning elected officials and bodies at local and regional level in the respective countries and examining a list of questions intended to guide the work and shape of the future Recommendation GT-RE(2020)2E-List of questions.docx - a presentation by Markku Mölläri (Finland) on the responsibility of municipal self-governments and local councils - a presentation on the Venice Commission's recent "Report on the recall of mayors and local elected representatives" (CDL-AD(2019)011rev) - a presentation on the outcomes of a meeting in 2019, with Ukrainian and international stakeholders on the accountability of local elected representatives in Ukraine. GT-RE(2020)3E-Accountability of local elected representatives in Ukraine.	During its second meeting, to take place by videoconference on 28 and 29 September, the GT-RE will resume its discussions - on the basis of replies to a questionnaire sent on 18 August to all CDDG members. Questionnaire Accountability elected - Further exchanges of views including with Mr Arnaud Duranthon, Strasbourg University, who will prepare a study based on the replies. The finalisation of the draft by the GT-RE and its subsequent adoption by the CDDG is scheduled for the second half of 2021.	Interaction with other Council of Europe bodies issuing standards, reports and other work of interest to the GT-RE – see the presentation on the Venice Commission's report on 14 February which was done by Pierre Garrone from the VC's Secretariat - will be continued. Particular attention will be paid throughout the GT-RE's work to the activity of the Congress of Local and Regional Authorities.
