Working Group: No Hate Web-No Hate Speech

Theme(s) discussed:

- hate speech and populism
- secularism, freedom of speech, freedom of religion
- internet and social networks

Aims:

- actively participating in and building relationships with all other actors in the field of hate speech within the Council of Europe: PACE platform, no hate speech movement (youth department of the Council of Europe, European Youth Centre), ECRI, etc., in the European institutions and in the civil society;
- building a European public space without hate speech.

Working languages: English and French

Date established: June 2015

Foreseen duration: From January 2015 to June 2017

Expected results:

Producing tools that could be shared in order to monitor, control and minimize hate speech. Collecting data, setting indicators, sharing those figures through a dashboard. To acquire an expertise that could lead to production of recommendations or resolutions, to be part of the solution expected by the civil society to fight hate speech.
