### Outline

#### Background and justification

The implementation of the Cybercrime@EAP II and Cybercrime@EAP III projects, focusing on matters of international cooperation and public-private partnerships in cybercrime and electronic evidence, reaches an important milestone by mid-2017 in terms of project management. Major studies are completed, regional meetings are held, and implementation of in-country activities is underway, with major sets of planned country-specific events already completed. At the same time, it is important, at this point of time in project lifecycle, to critically assess the performance against project objectives, identify the major gaps that could be addressed until the end of the project, and re-engage project teams and partners into discussion about the future activities that could take advantage of the expected project achievements.

The annual conference of the European Dialogue on Internet Governance (EuroDIG), to be held on 6-7 June in Tallinn, Estonia, is a fitting and relevant context for engaging project participants and partners into these discussions. Relevance of the topics in terms of data governance, jurisdiction and cooperation on security of cyberspace discussed during the EuroDIG 2017 to the international cooperation in terms of access to electronic evidence is evident, while the conference in itself is a forum for public-private cooperation and partnerships between the public sector and the Internet industry. Estonia is a partner for Cybercrime@EAP projects and its hosting of the event and the Planning Workshop/Steering Committee as one of the pre-events of the EuroDIG 2017 is an expression of this partnership.

Last but not least, the EuroDIG 2017 is one of the preparatory events for the Eastern Partnership Summit planned by the end of 2017 and contribution to the conference by the Cybercrime@EAP projects is relevant and important for reporting and visibility of project results in that context.

## Expected outcome

Carried out under Result/Immediate Outcome 1 of the Cybercrime@EAP II project (*the authorities responsible for mutual legal assistance in the six EAP countries will have better skills and tools (manual, online resources) for international co-operation on cybercrime and electronic evidence*) and Result/Immediate Outcome 2 of the Cybercrime@EAP III project (*a structured process of public/private cooperation on cybercrime underway and agreements concluded*), the activity is expected to achieve better coordination between the C-PROC and the EAP countries in terms of optimising and planning remaining and future project activities.

The event is also an opportunity for CEAP country teams to participate in the sessions relevant to the topics of international and public-private cooperation on cybercrime and electronic evidence in the framework of the EuroDIG 2017 conference hosted by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Estonia.

By the end of the Planning workshop/Steering Committee meeting, the participants and project partners would have discussed and decided on:

- Progress by Cybercrime@EAP projects up to date;
- Current gaps in project implementation to be addressed until the end of the project – focus on outputs;
- Possible additional activities in light of planned extension of both projects in 2018;

By attending the sessions of EuroDIG 2017, the participants should increase their knowledge and skills on the following:

- Issues of data and jurisdiction in the context of Internet Governance development;
- Full suite of issues related to human rights in a digital era, including privacy and data protection;
- All of the topics for discussion under the category of security and crime, including policies, strategies, cyber-security and child safety;
- Other sessions per interest and relevance to the project objectives.
