Budget of the Enlarged Partial Agreement on Sport (EPAS)

The Statutory Committee, under the terms of Article 5 of the Statute of the Enlarged Partial Agreement on Sport (EPAS), composed of the representatives on the Committee of Ministers of the member states of the Agreement¹, held its third meeting in Strasbourg on 6 October 2008. Resolves as follows:

2. The unexpended appropriations for the financial year 2007 amounting to €74 045.95, as shown in the budgetary management accounts (CM(2008)100, page 211) presented by the Secretary General, are cancelled;
3. The balance of €74 745.24 on the budget is hereby transferred to a suspense account of the partial agreement pending its allocation in the framework of the 2009 EPAS budget decisions.
4. The financial statements with the present resolution, as well as the report of the External Auditor, will be transmitted to the Committee of Ministers.
