ENLARGED PARTIAL AGREEMENT ON SPORT (EPAS)

4th Meeting of the Statutory Committee Strasbourg, 5 December 2008

Decisions

The Statutory Committee, under the terms of Article 5 of the Statute of the Enlarged Partial Agreement on Sport (EPAS), composed of the representatives on the Committee of Ministers of the member states of the Agreement¹, chaired by Ambassador Bruno Gain, Permanent Representative of France, held its fourth meeting in Strasbourg on 5 December 2008. Resolution EPAS-RES(2008)2 concerning the Enlarged Partial Agreement Sport 2009 Budget

(Adopted by the Statutory Committee on 5 December 2008, at their 4^{th} meeting)

The Statutory Committee, under the terms of Article 5 of the Statute of the Enlarged Partial Agreement on Sport (EPAS)¹, composed of the representatives on the Committee of Ministers of the member states of the agreement.

Having regard to Resolution CM/Res(2007)8 of 11 May 2007 authorising the establishment of the Enlarged Partial Agreement on Sport;

Having regard to Articles 19, 21 et 28 of the Financial Regulations;

Having regard to the draft budget for 2009 submitted by the Secretary General taking into account EPAS's budgetary proposals [EPAS-SC(2008)1] in accordance with Article 4 of the statute of EPAS;

Having regard to the recommendation of the Budget Committee on the draft budget for 2009 as set out in document EPAS-SC(2008)1,

Resolves as follows:

1. The budget of expenditure for 2009, totalling $\in 699\ 600$ and divided in heads and sub-heads according to Table A and the budget of receipts totalling $\in 699\ 600$ according to Table B appended hereto are hereby approved.

2. Approval is hereby given to the apportionment, among the states which are members of the Enlarged Partial Agreement on Sport of the contributions for 2009 totalling \in 699 600 according to Table C appended hereto.

3. The total of the budget of receipts shall be a function of actual receipts. The budget of expenditure and receipts will be adjusted accordingly in the course of the financial year.

4. The balance of \notin 74 745.24 on the budget for 2007, is hereby transferred to the special account "EPAS project" pending its allocation to specific projects to be decided by the EPAS Governing Board.
