


Children are discovering the world without guidance of their parents who are less and less equipped to follow them or assist them in making sense of the information that bombard them.




- Children & Teens tend to know much more than the adults

children/youth







The role of parents is being eroded by myriad of information exchanges among individuals by internet and cell phones.



NBS VAC: Exploitation and Abuse of Children Online






NATIONAL RESPONSE PLAN ON OSEC
