Convention on the Reduction of Cases of Multiple Nationality and on Military Obligations in Cases of Multiple Nationality

Strasbourg, 6.V.1963

Agreement on the interpretation of Article 12, paragraph 2

accepted by the Parties to the Convention – namely Austria, Belgium, Denmark, France, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Spain, Sweden and the United Kingdom – and certified by the Secretary General of the Council of Europe on 2 April 2007:

- Any Contracting Party may at any time, in so far as it is concerned, denounce Chapter I of this Convention by means of a notification addressed to the Secretary General of the Council of Europe.
- 2 Such denunciation shall take effect one year after the date of receipt by the Secretary General of such notification.
- The provisions of Article 7, paragraph 2, of the Convention shall apply as amended by the 1977 Protocol.
