and breakfast will be paid directly by the Council of Europe. Any extra hotel expenses will be borne by the participants.

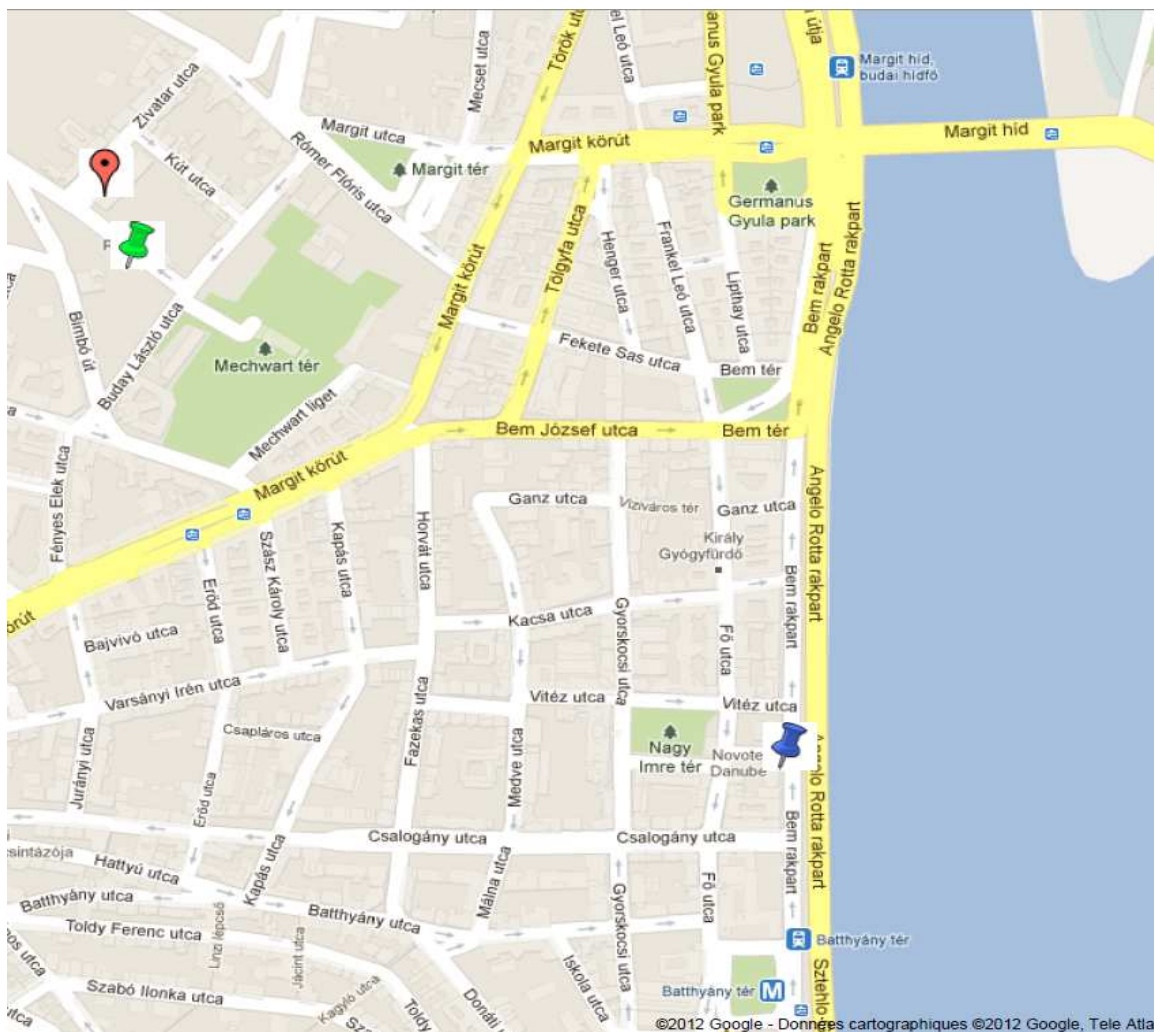
Lunches on 27 and 28 November 2012 at the European Youth Centre Budapest.
