Here are some of the follow up activities done by participants after the EYF (Re)generation seminar in order to disseminate the information acquired.

Ani (Armenia): organised PowerPoint presentations and posted on Facebook.

Natlie (Cyprus): organized training course and disseminated information also about EYF, role and objectives and plans to do the same in upcoming seminars.

Katie (Georgia): used social media (website and Facebook posts), and workshops for representatives from local NGOs.
