Legal Framework

 - RA 9208 (Anti-Trafficking Act as amended by RA 10364 or the Expanded Trafficking Act)



Strategic Objectives

- 1. Create and promote a nurturing and childfriendly cyberspace
- 2. Build and strengthen multi-level child protection system to safeguard children from online abuse violence and exploitation
- 3. Set up mechanisms to prevent online child victimization
- 4. Institute effective response mechanisms to address online child abuse and exploitation



KRA 1 Prevention and Advocacy

- 1 Collect information about online child victimization
- 2 Conduct relevant studies to address root causes of online pornography and cybersex
- 3 Community and school orientation on online safety
- 4 Institute safeguards (i.e. IP filtering, URL blocking of pornographic sites)
- 5 Enforce regulation of internet service providers, hosts, internet cafes, content administrators



KRA 2 Detection, investigation and prosecution of perpetrators

- 1 Enhance surveillance, investigative and prosecutorial skills of law enforcers and prosecutors
- 2 Update judges on appreciation of forensic evidence and technical terminologies
- 3 Establish modern cybercrime laboratories for law enforcement agencies
- 4 Develop child-friendly protocols in investigation and prosecution



KRA 3 Victim Response, Assistance and Rehabilitation

- 1 Set up effective response mechanisms for timely rescue of victims and prevention of possible victimization
- 2 Render assistance to victims (psychological and psychiatric intervention, livelihood assistance)
- 3 Institute inter-agency child friendly referral system



KRA 4 Strategic partnerships

- 1 Establish collaboration and coordination with civil society organizations, non-government organizations, internet service providers, international community
- 2 Involve partners in planning, implementation and resource mobilization
- 3 Improve monitoring mechanisms



KRA 5 Monitoring and Information Management

- 1 Develop efficient automated reporting systems
- 2 Establish comprehensive database on online child abuse, commercial exploitation, cyber pornography and cybersex
- 3 Set up interagency information sharing platform (National Justice Information System)
