- ◆ Designed to assist Commonwealth Countries develop capacity to address and combat Cybercrime. Driven by COMNET Foundation.
- ◆ Heads of Government endorsement in October 2011
- ◆ Organisations who contributed to the development of proposal : CoE, ITU, COMSEC, CTO, SOCA, UK department of Culture Media and sport, ICTA, Sri Lanka.

Since November 2011

- ◆ Setting up of a Governance Structure
- ◆ Secured an operational fund from Commonwealth Secretariat and Governments of Malta and UK for 2012.
- ◆ Translated a request for assistance into an in-country project in Africa.
- ◆ Currently translating regional requests of assistance and expressions of interest from Caribbean and Pacific into meaningful activity on the ground in both regions.
- ◆ Broadening the Partnership of CCI.

Governance Structure



- ◆ Inaugural steering group meeting took place on 28th Feb 2012
- ◆ CCI has an agreed Constitution Document
