
Cooperation against cybercrime – What future?

• The challenge of developing countries

- Internet user numbers are higher but IT systems are less advanced, and international cooperation mechanisms are less developed.
- In addition, victim awareness may be lower and law enforcement may lack access to training and investigative techniques
- Critical for success of international cooperation between high income countries that low and middle income countries are fully engaged at the cross-national level
