

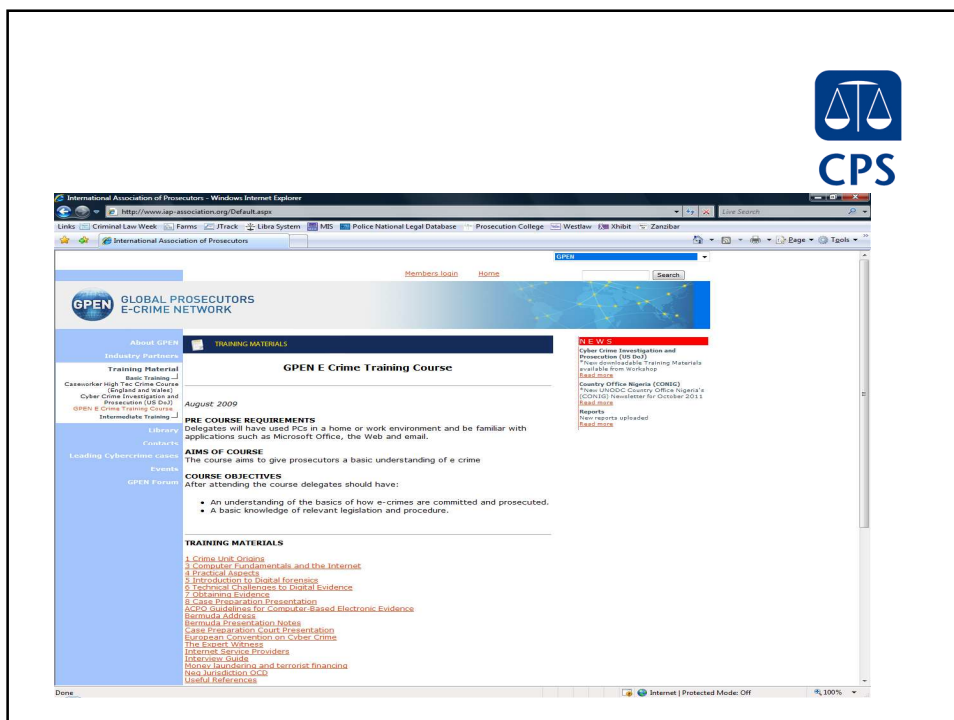
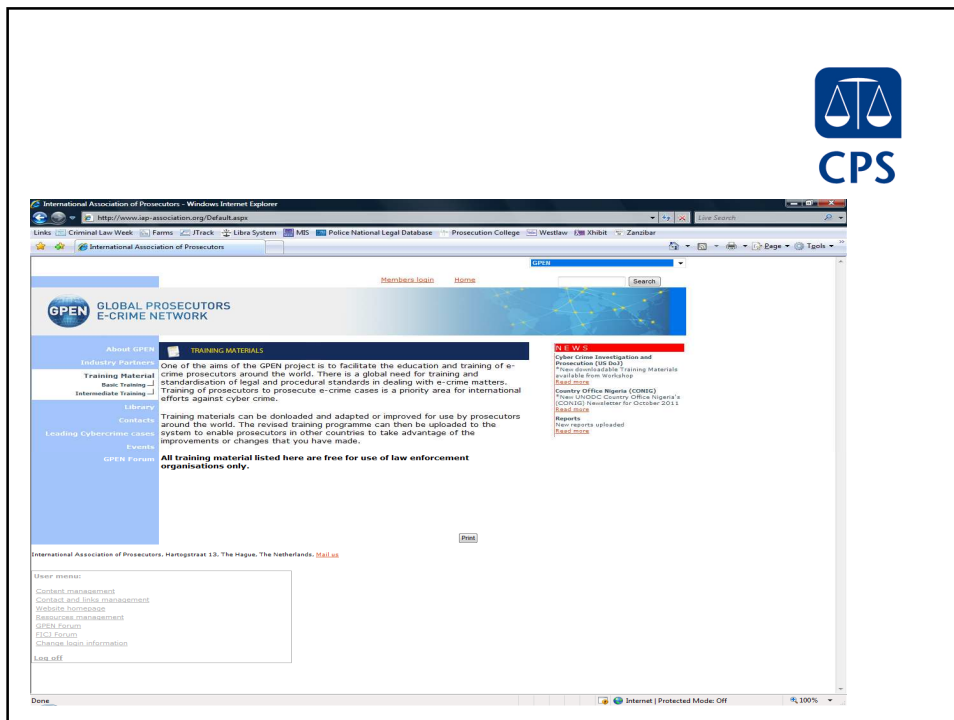

Security Breach Investigations Report 2010 (UK)
The UK Security Breach Investigations Report 2010 is a new fact-based report that provides detailed information thorough the analysis of current information security breaches in the UK.
Some of the findings: 80% of breaches came from external sources, 85% of cases resulted in stolen payment card information, and SQL injection was used in 60% of attacks. (SQL -Structured Query Language is a database computer language designed for managing data.)

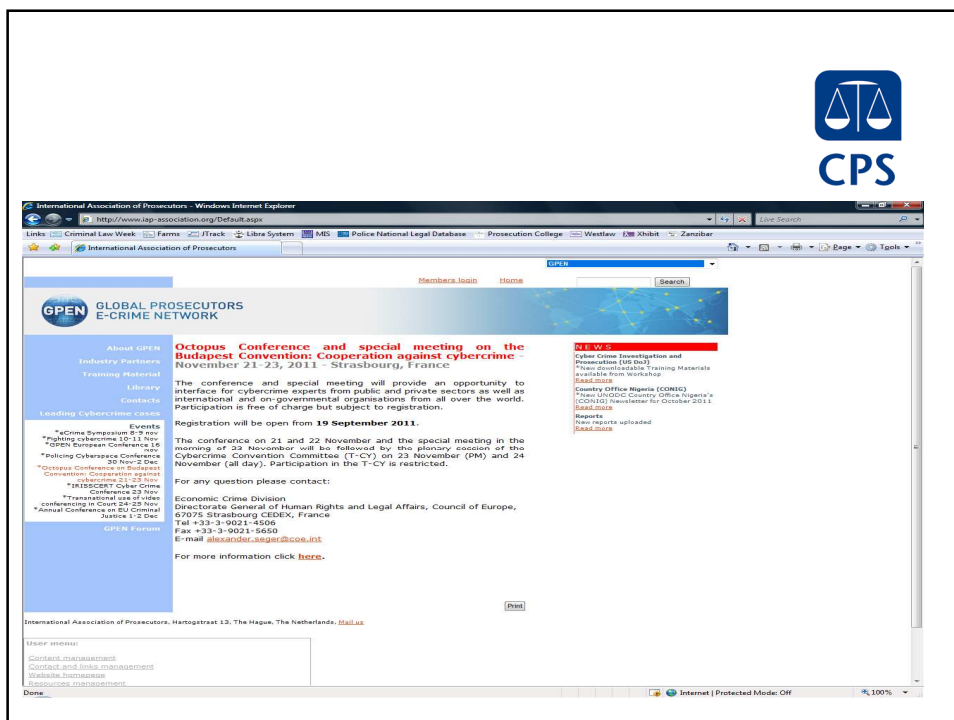
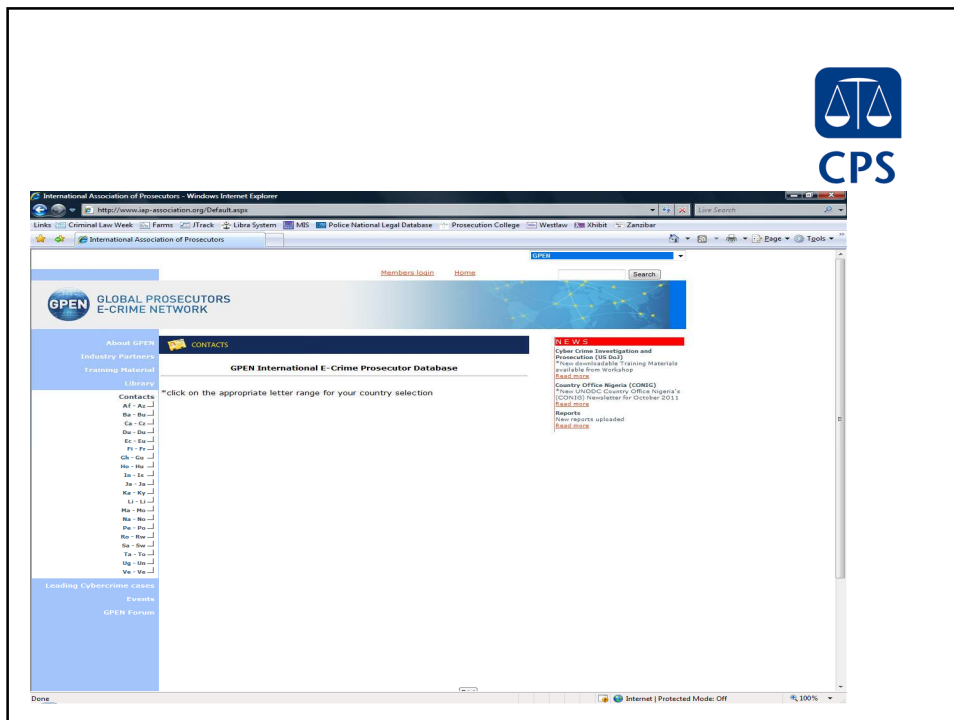
