WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

- Commercial sexual exploitation and abuse of children on the internet suspected to be a multi-million dollar enterprise
- Estimated 2,500-3,000 commercial child abuse websites in existence (IWF, 2007)
- Estimated 250-300 sites operating at any one time (IWF, 2007)
- Age of child victims has lowered significantly severity of abuse risen considerably (CEOP, 2009)
- 16.4% rise in child abuse image reports from the same period in 2006 (IWF, 2007)

OBJECTIVE OF THE EFC

To bring together all stakeholders involved in the fight against the commercial sale and distribution of child abuse images *to*:

- identify, locate and safeguard victims
- identify, locate and arrest offenders
- identify, trace and seize assets of offenders
- facilitate properly coordinated law enforcement investigations disrupt illegal activity
- educate and inform key stakeholders to better detect illegal activity
