Overview of possible binding and non-binding measures to improve the functioning of the Convention on the transfer of sentenced persons and its additional Protocol

Note by the Secretariat

The present note is a non-exhaustive overview of proposals and existing guidelines and tools elaborated by the PC-OC to facilitate the application of the Convention on the Transfer of sentenced Persons and its Additional Protocol. It seeks to assist the PC-OC in considering the most adequate steps to be taken for further improvement of these instruments, by the preparation of (a) new binding instrument(s) as proposed to the CDPC during its 66th meeting, or/and, where possible, by non-binding measures.

It is recalled that the CDPC during its 66th meeting had decided to "give the mandate to the PC-OC to continue its work on the updating/improving of the Convention on the Transfer of Sentenced Persons and its additional protocol and carefully consider which issues should be dealt with in (a) new binding instrument(s) or otherwise be dealt with in other ways which could be more effective than the "normative" one, i.e. operational/practical level."

Proposals for future action:

The summary of replies received to the questionnaires regarding the implementation of the Convention on the transfer of sentenced persons (ETS N° 112) and its Additional Protocol (ETS N° 167) identifies the problems raised by the Parties to these instruments as well as the solutions proposed. The Presentations made during the special session of the PC-OC on the transfer of sentenced persons in November 2013, and in particular the presentation by Ms Joana Gomes Ferreira (Portugal) on the future of the Convention on the Transfer of Sentenced Persons proposed different options for improvement (second additional Protocol, recommendation, practical guidelines).

Above documents were the main basis for the identification of problems to be addressed and proposals made to address them by the PC-OC Mod during its 17th meeting (List of decisions) and the PC-OC plenary (List of decisions) during its 66th meeting. See table below.

The Terms of reference require the PC-OC to ensure that (ii) the standard text providing information on the Convention on the Transfer of Sentenced Persons (appendix to Recommendation No. R (84)11) is completed with a text on the Additional protocol and the model request form appended to Recommendation No. R (92)18 is updated.

The e-transfer proposal by Israel to develop an electronic tool to facilitate transfer procedures is also to be considered [PC-OC Mod (2014)04].

Existing non-binding instruments and practical tools could be considered for further development or update. These concern:

- Rec. R (84) 11 by the Committee of Ministers concerning information about ETS°112
- Rec. R (88) 13 and R (92) 18 by the Committee of Ministers concerning the practical application of ETS°112
- Country information on the transfer of sentenced persons, (recently updated template);
- A guide to national procedures on transfer of sentenced persons PC-OC Inf 5 rev.4

 This guide might be outdated and in many aspects overlapping with the country information;
- Explanatory notes to the Convention and its Additional Protocol PC-OC Inf 67, (2003). This comprehensive document is based on the discussions that the PC-OC has entertained till 2003 about difficulties that have arisen or may arise in respect of the practical application of the two above-mentioned treaties, as well as the recommendations adopted by the Committee of Ministers concerning their practical application.
- National requirements with respect of languages in transfer requests PC-OC Inf 7 could be reconsidered.
