13 December 2006 Adoption of the UNCRPD by the General Assembly







Final observations

Committee UNCRPD






- Provide necessary support in the event of a disaster

- Disaster risk reduction must be fully accessible and disability inclusive



- Involve people with disabilities
- Develop and enforce accessible alert systems and protocols
- Organize training
