Final shape:

- compilation of (good / best) practice ?



### What is a "toolkit"?

A toolbox (also called **toolkit**, tool chest or workbox) is a box **to organize**, carry, and protect **the owner's tools**. They could be used for trade, a hobby or **Do-It-Yourself**, and their contents **vary with the craft of the owner**.

### Aims and realities

- Guarantee the safety of people in case of disasters
- Means available differ depending on the place in the world where a disaster happens
- Work with what is at hands
- What is at hands *can vary with the craft of the owner*.

### Glocalization

- "think globally, act locally"
- Importance of exchanging good practice
- Copy / paste does not work
- Transferability depends on the context

### Comparing the comparable

- Looking not only at strategies but also at the context
- Allow for decision makers living in comparable conditions to share their respective strategies and to learn from each other

Assessmentandidentification

Prevention, preparation, alert and warning

Emergency response

Posteresponse rehabilitation and remedial action
