<p>2. Status of signatures, ratifications, accessions to the Budapest Convention and its Protocol</p> <p>Participants are invited to discuss the <a href="#">status of signature, ratification</a> or accession by specific countries.</p>
<p>3. Information provided by parties and observers – Tour de table</p> <p>Participants are invited to present information on legislative developments, major cases, important events, training provided to other countries, including by international organisations etc.</p> <p>Signatories and States invited to accede are invited to report on progress made towards ratification/accession to the Budapest Convention on Cybercrime and its Protocol on Xenophobia and Racism.</p>
<p>4. Outcome of relevant international events</p> <p>Participants are invited to share information on recent international events of relevance to the work of the T-CY.</p>
<p>5. Dialogue with international organisations (T-CY observers)</p> <p>Representatives of international organisations with observer status in the T-CY are invited to present relevant activities and engage in a dialogue with T-CY members. Observers include the African Union Commission, European Union (Commission, ENISA, EUROJUST, EUROPOL), INTERPOL, ITU, OAS, OECD, OSCE, UNODC, and G7.</p>
<p>6. Follow up to T-CY Assessment Report on the expedited preservation provisions*</p> <p>The 13<sup>th</sup> Plenary is invited to consider in view adoption two draft reports:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Draft supplementary assessment report on the implementation of the preservation provisions of the Budapest Convention on Cybercrime (Document T-CY(2015)6). The T-CY is invited to consider the draft assessment prepared by the T-CY Bureau of Parties which did not participate in the assessment of the preservation provisions in 2012.</li> <li>- Draft report prepared by the T-CY Bureau (Document T-CY(2015)07) on follow up given by Parties to the assessment of the preservation provisions adopted in December 2012.</li> </ul>
<p>7. Provisions to be assessed in the 3<sup>rd</sup> round of T-CY assessments (2015)*</p> <p>T-CY 11 Plenary decided to dedicate the 3<sup>rd</sup> cycle of assessments on Article 13 (sanctions and measures). The 13<sup>th</sup> Plenary is invited to consider in view of adoption the draft questionnaire prepared by the Bureau (document T-CY(2015)03).</p>

Financial resourcing of the T-CY for 2015/16</b></p> <p>The Secretariat will inform participants on the state of financial resources available for the T-CY in 2015 and 2016.</p> <p>Following the decision on T-CY financing taken at the 9<sup>th</sup> Plenary, Parties are invited to consider financial support to the T-CY through voluntary contribution to the <a href="#">CYBERCRIME@OCTOPUS</a> project.</p>
<p><b>11. Activities of capacity building projects and the Cybercrime Programme Office of the Council of Europe (C-PROC)</b></p> <p>The Secretariat will provide an update of capacity building projects and the Council of Europe <a href="#">Programme Office on Cybercrime</a> (C-PROC) in Bucharest.</p>
<p><b>12. Cloud Evidence Group</b></p> <p>The T-CY CEG will provide an update on its work underway and invite comments on the draft discussion paper on challenges regarding criminal justice access to data in the cloud (Document T-CY(2015)10).</p>

<p><b>14. Next meeting of the T-CY*</b></p> <p>T-CY members are invited to decide on the proposal to hold T-CY 14 on 1 and 2 December 2015.
