

THE PROJECT «EDUCATION FOR DEMOCRACY»





The objective of EDC/HRE is to activate and encourage students in their roles as young citizens.

By teaching EDC / HRE we follow three principles:

- teaching "about" democracy and human rights;
- teaching "for" democracy and human rights;
- teaching "through"democracy and human rights.

Community project in the field of human rights education.

Students and teachers from the **ASM Lyceum** (project coordinators - **Pavel** Cerbuşca, Deputy Director, A. Ciorici, history teacher) in partnership with the **Association of Young Historians of Moldova** (ANTIM, project coordinator **Luchin T.**) had the honor to be selected to participate in the fifth edition of the European project "Summer Academy" held in Warsaw between 12 and 20 July

Community project in the field of human rights education.

Between 5 and 7 October in Warsaw, Poland, the "Democracy in School" conference took place, which was devoted to celebrating the fifth anniversary since the opening of the "Summer Academy" project. The event organizers, including the National Ministry of Education in Poland, the Center for Education and **Development in Poland, the Council of Europe, Wergeland Centre (based in Norway)** have aimed to highlight the good practices and exchange of experience in the field of education of the citizens' rights, which may serve as an inspiration for practitioners and decision makers from the states participating in the project. Normative documents of strategic importance serve as the basis, some of which are the *Universal Declaration of* Human Rights and the Charter of the Council of Europe, as well as national documents concerning democratic citizenship education and training in the field of Human Rights.



For this purpose, partnerships were created with the schools "Master Manole", "Sălcuţa", "Căuşeni", and the lyceums "Gaudeamus" "M. Eliade", "Horizont", "A. Puskin" from Chisinau, and others.

Community project in the field of human rights education.

Over the past five years, students and teachers of the high schools from various regions of Moldova have gathered at annual National Civic Forum to analyze community problems and make a relevant contribution for strengthening the civil society.



The main areas and topics of dialogue between teachers and students are: "Patriotism and love of the homeland", "Migration and Intercultural Dialogue", "Which way Moldova?", etc.

That's why in the ASM Lyceum many issues were addressed through the activity of the "We are Europe" Centre, that would also train high school students, parents, community members, and students at higher education institutions acting as experts in fields, mentors and members of the commission. An important contribution in this sense is being made by the non-governmental organizations with which the ASM Lyceum is collaborating, such as the General Association of Teachers of Romania, (Moldova subsidiary, AGIRo, president V. Dolha and AGIMd, president dr. M. Marin), Association of Young Historians Moldova (ANTIM, president S. Musteață and project coordinator Timur Luchin).



International Federation for Peace (UPF-Moldova general secretary, M. Calestru), National High School Debate League of Moldova (NHSDL, executive director I. Moldovan), EUROCLIO (executive director S. Stegers and project manager A. Gojayeva), Amnesty International Moldova (executive director C. Pereteatcu) and others.

The tasks of the Centre is to inform young people referring to the mentioned documents, the activation of self-government organizations in school and also, to involve the members of local community. A special contribution is being made by the School Senate, where elections are held following the model of the democratic states.

With this purpose, a group of volunteers was created. They aim to design and organize activities; facilitate events and initiatives in the education of the citizens' rights. The students volunteer were actively involved in the organization of activities, demonstrating initiative and civic activism, as well as willingness to participate through concrete actions at the process of changing the society in the fields of education, law and Page 9 **Human Rights.**

Among the activities to be organized in the ASM Lyceum and the community are:

- 1.Methodical materials based on "Compass" human rights education in the basic course "Civic education" and "I have the right to know their rights";
- 2.Class hours, using the principle of "different but equal" on the Compass program;
- 3.Organization of joint meetings of the school administration and the Senate, which are intended to create favorable conditions for achieving the objectives of the project;
- 4.Organization of regional competition debate with partners schools and students, who discussed the topic "Republic of Moldova has the opportunity to join the EU"
- 5. The organization of the National Civil Forum "Being a citizen of Europe" and the presentation of the bilingual guide: "Youth in Action" focusing on promoting civic engagement through the development and implementation of projects;
- 6.Organization of flash mobs, with the purpose to draw public attention to the problems of discrimination against individuals or groups, to stop the stereotypes and prejudices, thus contributing to the principle of "unity through diversity" and others,
- 7. 25 school students were the winners of the essay competition "If I will be the director ..."
- 8. 8 students conducted a research project on civic education. They have prepared to defend term papers;
- 9. There were conducted games and workshops with the students on the Day of Human Rights.






