**MEETING REPORT** 

#### **Item 1:** Opening of the meeting and adoption of the agenda

1. Drafting Group G on the reform of the Court (GT-GDR-G) held its 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting in Strasbourg from 14 to 16 October 2014 with Mr Vít A. SCHORM (Czech Republic) in the Chair. The list of participants appears at <u>Appendix I</u>. The agenda, as adopted, appears at <u>Appendix II</u>.

# <u>Item 2:</u> The procedure for the amendment of the Rules of Court and the possible 'upgrading' to the Convention of certain provisions of the Rules of Court

- 2. Ms Cordelia EHRICH (Switzerland), rapporteur, presented the draft CDDH report containing conclusions and possible proposals for action concerning the procedure for the amendment of the Rules of Court and the possible "upgrading" to the Convention of certain provisions of the Rules of Court. It was drafted on the basis of the outline adopted by the Group at its 1<sup>st</sup> meeting and in accordance with the guidelines subsequently given by the DH-GDR and the CDDH. The Group examined and adopted the CDDH draft report as it appears at Addendum I, after having examined the written comments submitted by experts in advance of the meeting, as well as other proposals formulated during the meeting. The draft report will be transmitted to the DH-GDR for examination at its next meeting (5-7 November 2014). The Group thanked Ms Ehrich for her contribution to its work.
- 3. In the course of its discussions, the Group decided to record the following points in the meeting report:
  - As regards the criterion for identifying proposals for amendment of the Rules of Court that should be subject to a new procedure, one expert suggested that it should be further developed to specify that the procedure should apply when the amendment would significantly affect the rights and obligations of the parties "under the Convention or creates new rights or obligations". This suggestion did not meet with support.
  - As regards use of an informal agreement between the Court and the High Contracting Parties as a means for the possible introduction of the new, most flexible procedure, the Group agreed that it would be for the Committee of Ministers to define the exact modalities.
  - Generally, the Group agreed that it would now fall to the DH-GDR and then the CDDH, in fulfilment of the terms of reference, to indicate whether or not there was consensus on the different proposals set out.

5. With the adoption of the above-mentioned draft CDDH report, the Group considered that it had fulfilled its terms of reference. It expressed its appreciation for the constructive approach shown by members throughout its work and its thanks to the Chairperson for the way in which he had conducted its meetings.
