## 2 Apr 2015 - Form concerning Miktat Algül submitted by EFJ/IFJ under "Alawite Journalist Miktat Algül Sentenced to 61 Years in Turkey"

## Information provided by the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Turkey

Within the framework of organized crimes, Miktat Algül was tried and sentenced to a total imprisonment of 61 years and 3 months with the decision of 7<sup>th</sup> Chamber of the Adana High Criminal Court. The decision became final upon the upholding judgment of the 6<sup>th</sup> Criminal Chamber of the Court of Cassation. Miktat Algül was tried and convicted due to the following offences:

- Threatening by using the names of crime organization
- Blackmailing
- Establishing an organization with a view to committing crimes
- Depriving a person of liberty by using physical power, threat and deception
- Plundering in favor of a crime organization
- Committing a grave violation of the respect for home.
