With a view to assessing the conformity of the situation as regards the rights of persons with disabilities, the Committee requests the following information:

- whether there is anti-discrimination legislation covering education;
- whether there is anti-discrimination legislation covering employment;
- whether there is anti-discrimination legislation covering social integration and participation in the life of the community.

The additional information

According to the Law of Ukraine "On Amending Certain Laws of Ukraine on the Rights of Persons with Disability" dated December 22, 2011, № 4213 - VI the Article 2 of the Law of Ukraine "On the Basis of Social Protection of Disabled People in Ukraine" prohibits discrimination based on disability.

According to Article 26 of the Law of Ukraine "On Protection of Childhood" discrimination of disabled children and children with mental or physical disability is prohibited.

It should be noted that the Draft Law "On the Basis of Preventing and Combating Discrimination in Ukraine" prepared by the Government has been registered in the Parliament of Ukraine. The Draft Law defines organizational and legal basis of preventing and combating discrimination for the purpose of equal opportunities of realisation of human rights and freedoms.

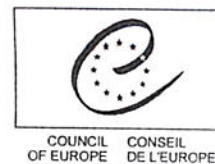
