The Committee will adopt Conclusions XIX-4 (2011) of the 1961 Charter for the following states:

Austria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Iceland, Latvia, Luxembourg, Poland, Spain, "the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia", United Kingdom
