#### **National reports for Conclusions 2012 of the Charter and Conclusions XX-1 (2012) of the 1961 Charter**

**Article 1: The right to work**, will be examined by the Committee.

The Committee will adopt **Conclusions 2011** for Hungary who submitted its 1<sup>st</sup> report on the Revised Charter only in July 2012, failing to meet the October 2010 deadline.
