High-level political conference on the Charter in Turin, Italy

A high-level conference will be held in Turin in October 2014 for which preparations are underway.

Examination of national reports for conclusions 2013 of the Charter and Conclusions XX-2 (2013) of the 1961 Charter

Articles 3, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23 and 30 will be examined. The following countries are concerned: Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Ireland, Spain, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, "The former Ex-Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia", Georgia, Greece, Latvia, Poland, Turkey and United Kingdom.

Adoption by country of Conclusions 2013 of the Charter and Conclusions XX-2 (2013) of the 1961 Charter

Conclusions will be adopted for the following countries: Albania, Andorra, Armenia, Austria, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Estonia, Finland, France, Georgia, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Lithuania, Malta, Republic of Moldova, Montenegro, Netherlands, Norway, Russian Federation, Romania, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Sweden, Turkey, Ukraine, Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Greece, Latvia, Poland, Spain, "The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia" and United Kingdom.
