Examination of national reports for Conclusions 2014 of the Charter and Conclusions XX-3(2014) of the 1961 Charter

The Committee is in the course of examining country reports submitted for the current reporting cycle covering Charter provisions relating to labour rights.

It will examine the situation in the following countries: Finland, Denmark, Serbia, Norway, Romania, Montenegro, the Republic of Moldova, Italy and Armenia.
