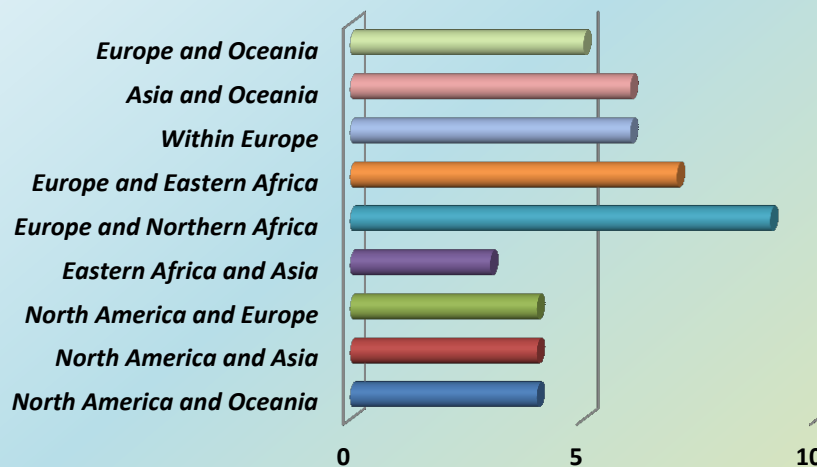

# PILOT PHASE 2013: e-EXTRADITION TRIAL TRANSMISSIONS

## NUMBER OF e-EXTRADITION TRANSMISSIONS BY REGION



**9 states from 6 regions participated**  
**50 successful e-extradition trial transmissions conducted**  
**Shortest transmission time only 2 days**

✓ Absolute integrity of documents

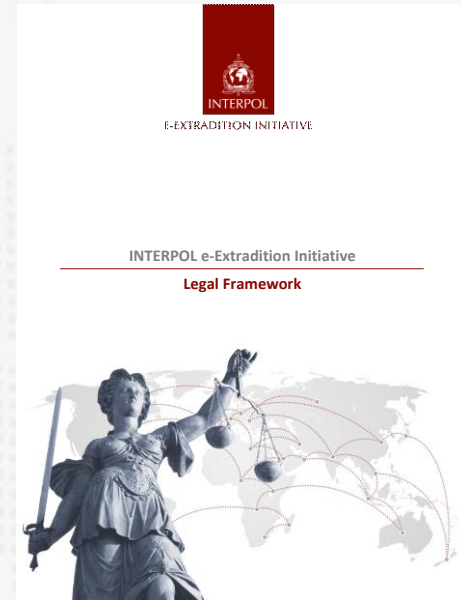
