The following recommendations are addressed to the competent national authorities of all Contracting Parties, Observer States and other interested countries:

- Mobilise financial and human resources at national level, both internal or external
- Seek advice from the Secretariat of the Bern Convention, both on issues linked to the constitution process of the Network and the resource mobilisation process before external donors
- Reinforce cooperation with civil society sector, in particular nature conservation NGOs and sector in general which often have robust and updated ecological data available, with can be used for starting operations on the Emerald Network setting-up
- Reinforce coherence between any action implemented at national level on the setting-up of the Natura 2000 Network and work on the establishment of the Emerald Network
- Act towards increasing the visibility of the Emerald network, its objectives and longterm benefits at national level, both to the general public and political decision-makers






