RUSSIAN STUDENT CORPS OF RESCUERS (RSCOR) – Youth Wing of RUOR



*53 regional offices in Russia
more than 12 000 voluntary rescuers
including ~ 5'500 qualified rescuers
215 voluntary rescue teams*



*Young rescuers are constantly trained: rescue on water objects, in the mountains, in the forests, urban search and rescue, industrial climbing, car extraction, etc.
They can professionally respond to any kind of emergency, save and protect people and assets, inform and guide disaster risk reduction actions and policies*





RUSSIAN STUDENT CORPS OF RESCUERS (RSCOR) – Youth Wing of RUOR



RUOR Youth is engaged in liquidation the consequences of emergency situations, search and rescue operations, humanitarian actions.



Volunteers organize and participate in different national and international competitions



***Young rescuers have the capability to innovate, educate and reach out to their families as well as their wider community on how to reduce the risks of disasters;
They are credible stakeholders in national and local level disaster risk management, including risk assessments, disaster risk management planning, monitoring, and evaluation.***

Each step in the “School of safety” has specified complexity according to the adopted education program



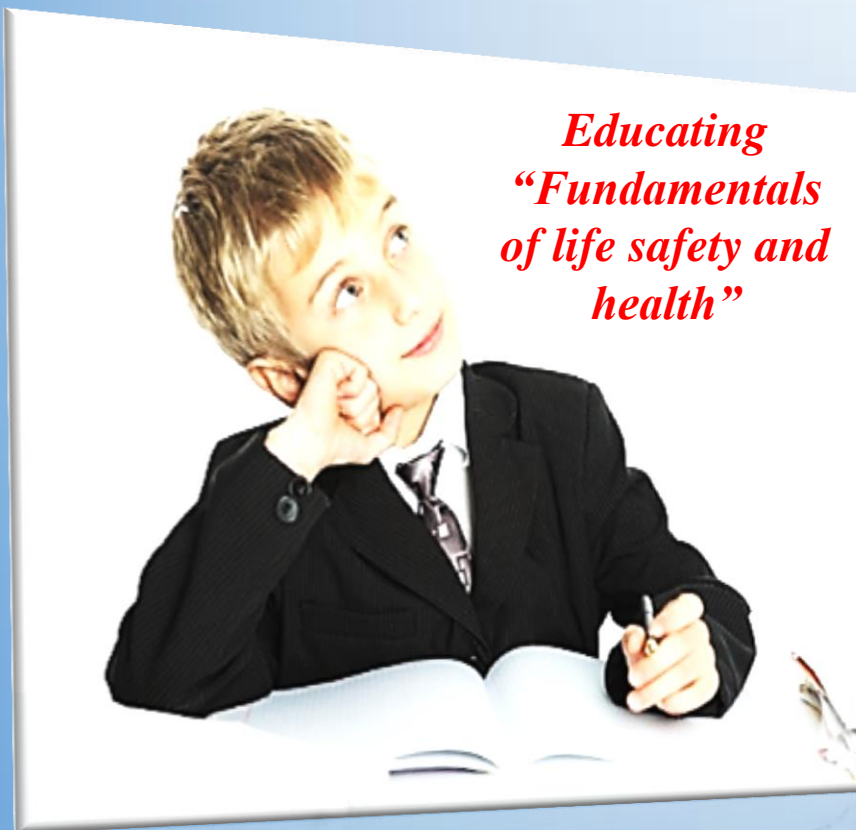
“School of Safety” unites more than 5.5 million children

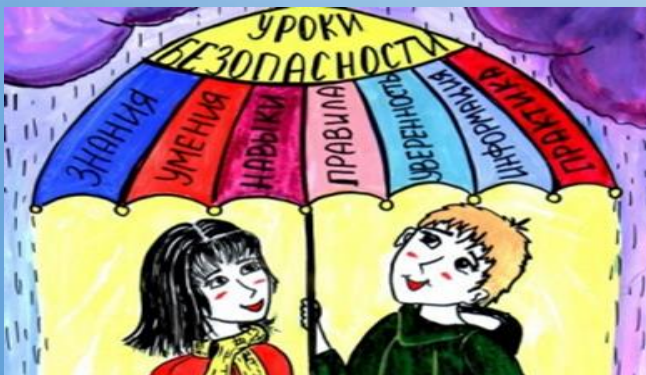

Hostage siege in Beslan

1-3 September 2004



July 2005

Start of the Disaster risk reduction, Education, Sport, and Resilience building for the children of Beslan

The programme includes the following:

- basic safety rules in emergency and natural hazards conditions
- first aid
- training courses on safe climbing and skiing
- psychosocial rehabilitation: art and play therapy sessions
- hippotherapy
- lectures on HIV/AIDS, drug prevention and healthy life style, etc



Every week a mixed group of 15 adolescents – 50% those who have been taken hostages and 50% from other schools of Beslan – benefited from the project .

Children who in the beginning have been anxious, helpless and aggressive with disorganized and agitated behavior became more confident and self-esteemed, more open and tolerant, with brighter emotions and confidence in future.





Young people trained in the project trained other groups of rents and youths, building the capacity of people who were affected by, and responded to disasters

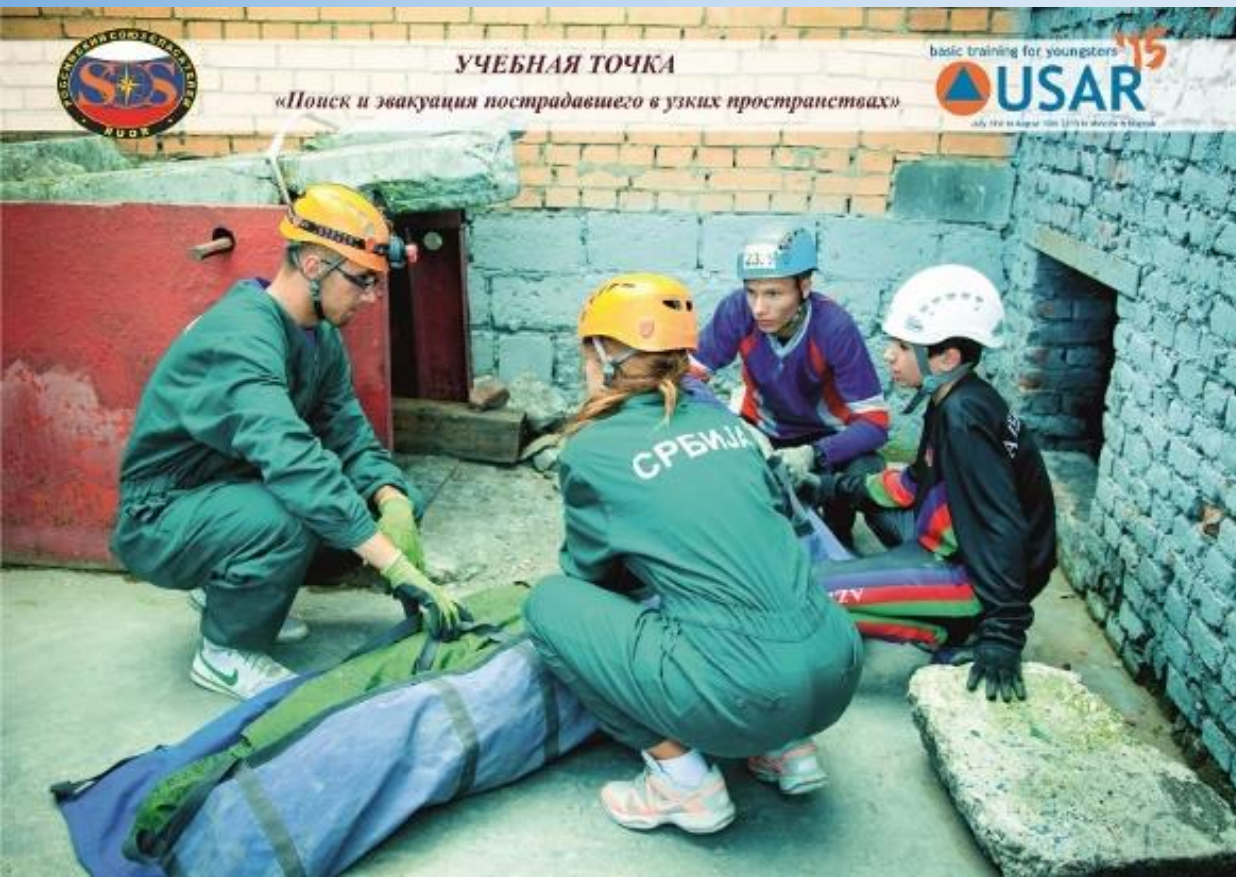

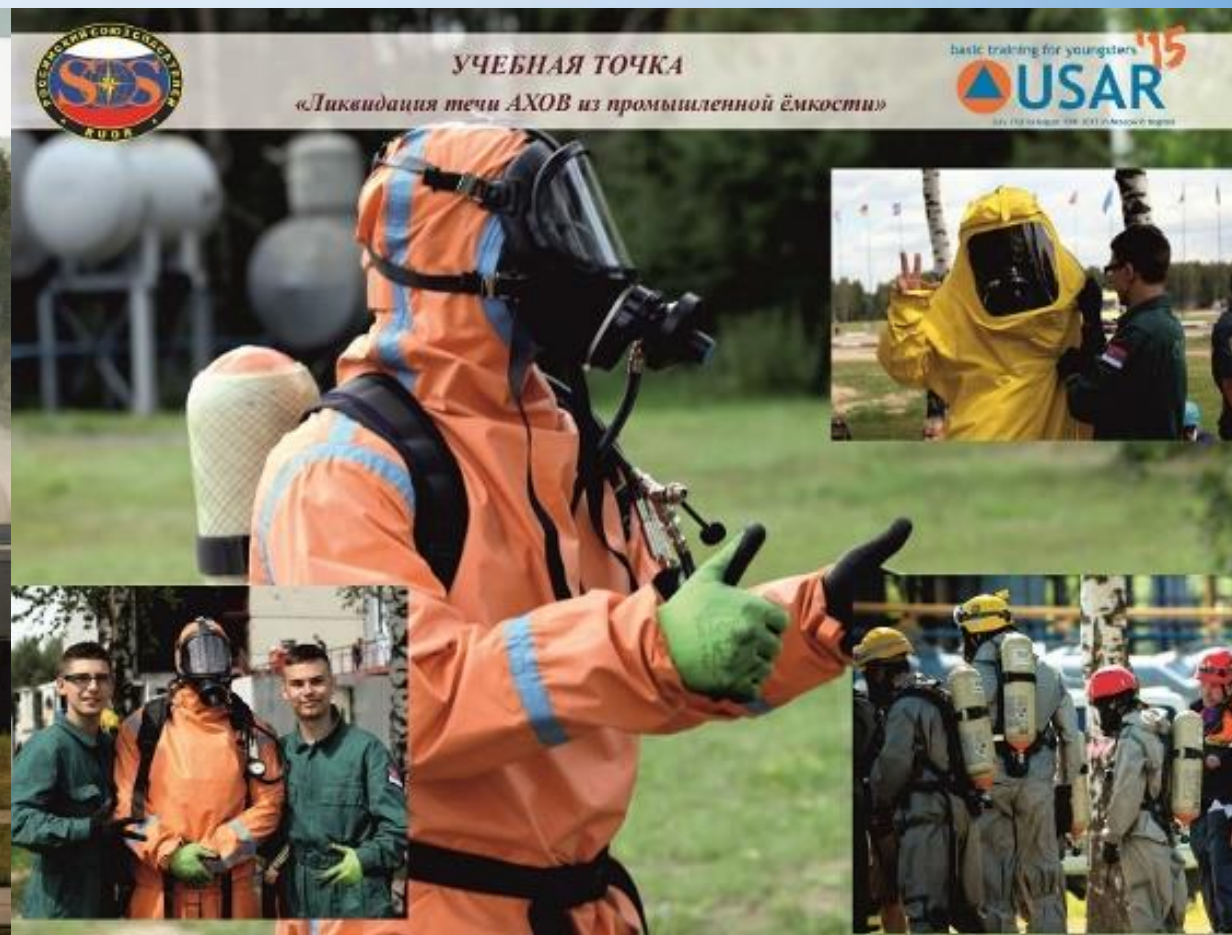
