The Deputies

- noted that the Steering Committee for Urban Policy and the Architectural Heritage (CDUP) has executed the terms of reference assigned to it by Decision No. CM/150/140979 (see CM(82)158 and CM(83)73):
- ii. adopted the following reply to Assembly Recommendation 872:

"The Committee of Ministers recalls the reply that it gave to Assembly Recommendation 872 on industrial archaeology in September 1980 (Doc. 4579, Addendum). The Committee of Ministers included in the 1983 programme an activity relating to the protection of the industrial heritage (Activity 18.6.1) and aiming at the study of the concept of industrial archaeology in the different countries as well as of policies for the protection of the heritage concerned. At its third meeting (February 1983) the Steering Committee for Urban Policy and the Architectural Heritage (CDUP) instructed two experts to take stock in 1983 of the problems existing and the solutions found in regard to the industrial heritage both in the various member States and in the specialised international organisations, with special reference to the aspects specific to the industrial heritage of southern Europe.

These various studies could be examined by the CDUP early in 1984 and serve as a basis for future activities on this subject."
