MEETING REPORT

Item 1: Opening of the meeting, adoption of the agenda and order of business

1. Drafting Group "C" on the reform of the Court (GT-GDR-C) held its 2nd meeting in Strasbourg from 30 January – 1 February 2013 with Mr Martin KUIJER (The Netherlands) in the chair. The Group heard a welcoming presentation by Mr Jörg POLAKIEWICZ, Head of the Human Rights Policy and Development Department.

Item 2: Interim measures under Rule 39 of the Rules of Court

2. The Rapporteur, Mrs Yasmine AHMED (United Kingdom), presented her draft CDDH report on interim measures under Rule 39 of the Rules of Court. The Group examined and adopted the draft CDDH report as it appears at <u>Addendum I</u>, with a view to its transmission to the DH-GDR for examination at its next meeting (13-15 February 2013). The Group thanked the Rapporteur for her contribution to its work.

Item 3: "Representative application procedure"

3. The Rapporteur, Mr Morten RUUD (Norway), presented his draft CDDH report on the advisability and modalities of a "representative application procedure". The Group examined and adopted the draft CDDH report as it appears at <u>Addendum II</u>, with a view to its transmission to the DH-GDR for examination at its next meeting (13-15 February 2013). The Group thanked the Rapporteur for his contribution to its work.

Item 4: Adoption of the conclusions and meeting report

4. With the adoption of the two above-mentioned draft CDDH reports, the Group considered that it had fulfilled its terms of reference. It expressed its appreciation for the constructive approach shown by members throughout its work and its thanks to the Chairperson for the way in which he had conducted its meetings.
