

Characteristics

- No full e-voting solution
- only electronic processing of postal ballots
- for fast preliminary results (non-binding)
- implemented with scanners













Why this solution?

- Central processing of postal ballots has to be done by the National Election Office – high workload
- Voters and parties are used to fast results
- Paper trail methods are better verifiable by observers



Why not legally binding?

- Short time to implement and audit this new technique
- Parties not prepared for electronic observation
- Lack of trust between political parties
- Developers did not give full access to source code
- Legal integrity of election comes first



Scanners in practice

- 128.378 ballots counted as valid by scanners
- Manual recount (multiple times) in presence of party observers and the OSCE: 128.429 valid ballots
- Difference of 51 ballots
- Reason: scanners did not recognize votes cast with green ink



The Future

If the Parliament approves, scanners could be implemented at foreign voting locations
