Municipal Elections 2013

I-voters:

2013 municipal elections: 133 808 (24,3% of participating voters)

2011 parliamentary elections: 140 846 (21,2% of participating voters)



Amendments to Election Laws (2011)

- Rules for not starting, suspension and termination of I-voting
- Testing, auditing and observation rules to be laid out by NEC
- Electronic Voting Committee (EVC) established
- Invalid I-votes defined (1 invalid vote in 2013)
- Vote verification



Electronic Voting Committee

- Established in 2012
- Members are IT professionals
- Responsible for conducting I-voting

Verification of I-votes

- Confirms that the vote was received as intended
- Enables to check the voter's computer against malware infections
- Smart device as an independent verification channel
- Requirements for the device: camera, Internet connection, downloaded verification app




Verification of I-votes (cont.)






Internet voting application

Verification of I-votes: Results

- First test run during 2013 municipal elections
- Android devices, support for iOS and WP to be added
- 4696 (3,43%) I-votes verified (expected goal 2%)
- Currently results are legally non-binding
- Required by law from 2015
