








# **EQUINET – the European Network of Equality Bodies**

- Overview of activities



### What are equality bodies?

- Equality bodies are public institutions set up across Europe to promote equality and tackle discrimination on grounds of gender, race, age, sexual orientation, religion and belief, disability or other grounds.

- Functions








## Examples of litigation led initiatives by equality bodies

- A key barrier: under-reporting








#### **Conclusions**
