### 1. Introduction


The Institute for the Equality of Women and Men : an Equality Body specifically dedicated to gender discrimination





- Assist victims of gender discrimination
- Conduct independant surveys
- Publish independant reports and make recommendations

# Law of 22 May 2014 against sexism in public spaces



"WHAT MAKES YOU THINK YOU WOULD BE A GOOD BUTT FOR OUR SEXIST JOKES?"



Drawing on the experiences of women, render specific types of behaviour punishable

A first at international level

Signal = clear rejection of sexist behaviour

## Legal definition punishable sexism

"... sexism is defined as any gesture or behaviour which, in the circumstances as described in article 444 of the Criminal Code, is clearly intended to express contempt for a person because of her/his gender, or regards her/him as inferior for the same reason, or reduces her/him to her/his sexual dimension, and which causes a serious violation of her/his dignity"





### Sanction

### Sexism is punishable

" by a prison term from one month up to one year and a fine of fifty to one thousand euros, or only one of these penalties,..."



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### « Gesture or behaviour »

#### In public circumstances

For instance : in a public place, in the street, in the workplace, in the presence of several people, in the media, on social networks Has to explicitly address one person or more who can be identified

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The law does not apply to unidentified groups, such as « women » or « men »

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Does not apply to advertising



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### Gesture or behaviour has to

- express contempt for a person because of her/his gender
- regard her/him as inferior because of their gender
- reduce her/him mainly to her/his sexual dimension

Non-cumulative criteria



#### Intentional behaviour which is sufficiently serious

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The author knows that his/her behaviour can affect, harm, denigrate, hurt the person.

> The judge evaluates the gravity of the violation of dignity, taking into account **objective facts** and the **context**.

> > No joke or humorous video



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### Conclusion

#### Law is criticized

The merit to set the limits of what is acceptable or not.

A clear message : sexism cannot be tolerated in our society.

Now we have to make the law effective



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### 3. Make legislation effective


- 3a. Circular of 2006 concerning criminal policy with regard to intimate partner violence (COL4/2006)
- 3b. Circular of 2013 concerning investigative policy towards discriminations and hate crimes (including gender-based discriminations) (COL13/2013)



### 3a. Circular «intimate partner violence»

A uniform criminal policy concerning intimate partner violence intended for police and public prosecution services





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## Specifically

- Action plans concerning prosecution for this type of violence per district
- Public prosecutors and police officers who act as contact points
- Guidelines to handle situations of intimate partner violence
- Measures to ensure the protection of victims



### Conclusion

- Good tool to protect victims and approach perpetrators : not only repressive, it also prevents recidivism.
- Positive change in mentalities
- Systematic consideration by the police
- More of a priority for the legal system



### 3b. Circular « discrimination »

- Ensure a uniform investigative and prosecution policy concerning discriminations and hate crimes
- Set up a structure to support the cooperation between different actors




