- English and French laws; Mauritian law
 - Judicial Committee of the Privy Council
 - Supreme Court
 - Lower Courts, e.g., District court
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- Lois anglaise et française; Loi mauricienne
- Conseil Privé
- Cour Suprême
- Tribunaux inférieurs; ex., Cour de district



The Institute for Judicial and Legal Studies

- Created by : Institute for Judicial and Legal Studies Act 2011 [Act 26 of 2011] – 1 Oct. 2011
 - CPD for Barristers, Attorneys and Notaries
 - Objects of Institute:
 - Foster continuing judicial and legal education
 - Promotion international exchanges and co-operation with other jurisdictions in the field of judicial and legal studies
 - Training for Police Prosecutors and Public Officers
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- Créée par Institute for Judicial and Legal Studies Act 2011 [Act 26 of 2011] – 1 oct. 2011
 - FPC pour Avocats, Avoués et Notaires
 - Objectifs de l'Institut:
 - Favoriser la formation en droit et judiciaire continue
 - Promouvoir les échanges et coopérations internationales avec d'autres pays dans le domaine des études en droit et judiciaire
 - Formation pour la Police et les officiers publics



The Institute for Judicial and Legal Studies

- Board
 - Chairperson, Judiciary (3), Solicitor-General (Rep), DPP (Rep), 3 law practitioners and other members
 - Power to engage resource persons and consultants, e.g., to conduct courses
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- Le Conseil
 - Présidente, Judiciaire (3), Solicitor-General (Rép), DPP (Rép), 3 juristes et autres membres
 - Pouvoir de retenir les services des intervenants et consultants; ex., pour dispenser des cours

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Challenges for judicial officers

- Lawyers (3 branches) : Minimum 12 hours in an academic year
 - Heavy workload
 - TOT & Audit: Identification of a few trainers who can act as international resource persons
 - Interaction with other jurisdictions. International advanced training & interaction required.
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Challenges pour les membres du judiciaire

- Juristes (3 branches): Minimum 12 heures dans une année académique
- Charge de travail considérable
