# Terms of Reference of the Subordinate Committee on Heritage and Landscape Conventions

Name of committee (acronym): SCHLC

**Category: subordinate body** 

Set up by the Committee of Ministers under Article 17 of the Statute of the Council of Europe and in accordance with Resolution CM/Res(2011)24 on intergovernmental committees and subordinate bodies, their terms of reference and working methods

#### **Duration: 1... 2012 until 31 December 2013**

#### Main tasks

Under the authority of the Steering Committee for Culture, Heritage and Landscape (CDCPP) and with reference to the Council of Europe cultural heritage and landscape conventions, the Subordinate Committee will present to the CDCPP an assessment of the results achieved by the Programme of Activities and of the main issues at stake in the member states. The Committee will propose political follow-up enabling the development of new activities in a multilateral and integrated perspective, to ensure impact and sustainability.

- European Convention on the Protection of the archaeological heritage (revised), Valletta (CETS no. 143),
- Convention for the Protection of the architectural heritage of Europe, Granada (CETS no. 121).
- Framework Convention on the value of cultural heritage for society (CETS no. 199),
- European Landscape Convention, Florence (CETS no. 176).

# Pillar/ Sector/ Programme

Pillar: Democracy

**Sector:** Sustainable democratic societies

**Programme:** - Democratic Citizenship through education, culture and youth policies

### **Expected results during the biennium**

- 1. Provide assistance to member states in the implementation of the cultural heritage and landscape conventions;
- 2. Propose to member states actions in line with countries' needs and priorities and the Council of Europe objectives;
- 3. To promote the conventions with a view to enlarging the number of ratifications and Parties.

#### **Members:**

10 experts appointed by the governments of member States of the Council of Europe and

of other states having acceded to the European Cultural Convention, as well as cultural heritage and landscape conventions.

The experts will be requested to prepare documents to be examined by the CDCPP.

The Council of Europe budget will bear the travel and subsistence expenses of the 10 experts.

# **Participants:**

- The Parliamentary Assembly may send one or more representatives to meetings of the Committee, without the right to vote and at the charge of its administrative budget.
- The Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe may send one or more representatives to meetings of the Committee, without the right to vote and at the charge of its administrative budget.
- The Council of Europe Conference of INGOs, without the right to vote and at the charge of its administrative budget.

#### **Working methods**

#### **Meetings:**

The Subordinate Committee shall elect a Chair and a Vice-chair.

The Chair, with the agreement of the Committee and in accordance with any conditions and arrangements it decides on, may invite particularly competent figures in the cultural heritage and landscape fields to take part in the work of the Committee without the right to vote and within the limit of its available budget.

If necessary, and in order to implement its work, the Subordinate Committee may entrust a restricted number of its members with specific tasks.
