Who will benefit?

- ▶ Verkhovna Rada;
- ▶ Ministry of Justice;
- ▶ National Anti-Corruption Bureau;
- ▶ National Agency for Prevention of Corruption; and
- ▶ Representatives of law enforcement agencies, prosecution service, the judiciary, civil society and media.

The aims of the project

- ▶ Strengthen institutional capacities to counter corruption in Ukraine, in accordance with European standards;
- ▶ Increased legislative compliance with anti-corruption standards;
- ▶ Strengthen capacities of National Anti-corruption Bureau;
- ▶ Strengthen Institutional capacities for (Recovered/Seized) Asset Management; and
- ▶ Support National Agency for Prevention of Corruption (NAPC) and strengthening of anti-corruption prevention measures.

How will the project work?

- ▶ As an open advisory facility capable of addressing differing requests from Ukraine and changing landscape in the field.

Project activities

- ▶ Legislative reviews and provision of advice on improvement;
- ▶ Provision of institutional and operational advisory services;
- ▶ Professional skills development programs on economic crime investigations, international cooperation, and asset recovery, among other topics; and
- ▶ Advice on development of preventive mechanisms, including codes of ethics.

How much will it cost?

- ▶ The total budget for the project is 100,000 Euros

Length of project

- ▶ the Project runs from 1 January 2016 to 31 December 2017
