 Terms of reference of the Committee of Experts on the System of the European Convention on Human Rights (DH-SYSC) for 2016-2017 DH-SYSC(2016)003

In accordance with its terms of reference for the biennium 2016-2017, the DH-SYSC is required, concerning Recommendation CM/Rec (2008)2 on efficient domestic capacity for rapid execution of judgments of the European Court of Human Rights, to "take stock of its implementation and make an inventory of good practices relating to it and, if appropriate, provide for updating the recommendation in the light of practices developed by the States Parties (deadline: 30 June 2017)"). Preparatory work has been entrusted to DH-SYSC-REC.

At its 9th meeting, the DH-SYSC agreed that the results of the 1st meeting of the DH-SYSC-REC could be submitted to the DH-SYSC at its 2nd meeting so that the DH-SYSC can decide on the possible updating of the recommendation. On the basis of the decisions and guidance of the DH-SYSC and the CDDH, the Group could meet for a second time at the beginning of 2017 to present its work for consideration and adoption by the DH-SYSC at its 3rd meeting, in spring 2017 (see DH-GDR(2015)R9 Appendix III).

At its 1st meeting, the DH-SYSC instructed the Secretariat to prepare a document containing a) good practice in the member States and b) a first stocktaking of the implementation of the recommendation, pursuant to the sources proposed by the Secretariat in document DH-SYSC (2016)007 (§§ 3-5) and following the structure of Recommendation (2008)2.

The Group is invited to examine the working document prepared by the Secretariat in light of the guidance given by the DH-SYSC. It is also invited to define its working methods for the present meeting and for the continuation of its work with a view to the 2nd meeting of the DH-SYSC (8-10 November 2016).
