(49 urban and 866 rural)

- State Government
- Governors- appointed by the Government
- State Budget

## Communities

- Local Self-Government
- Local authorities (Head of community and community council)- directly elected (except Yerevan)
- Local Budget

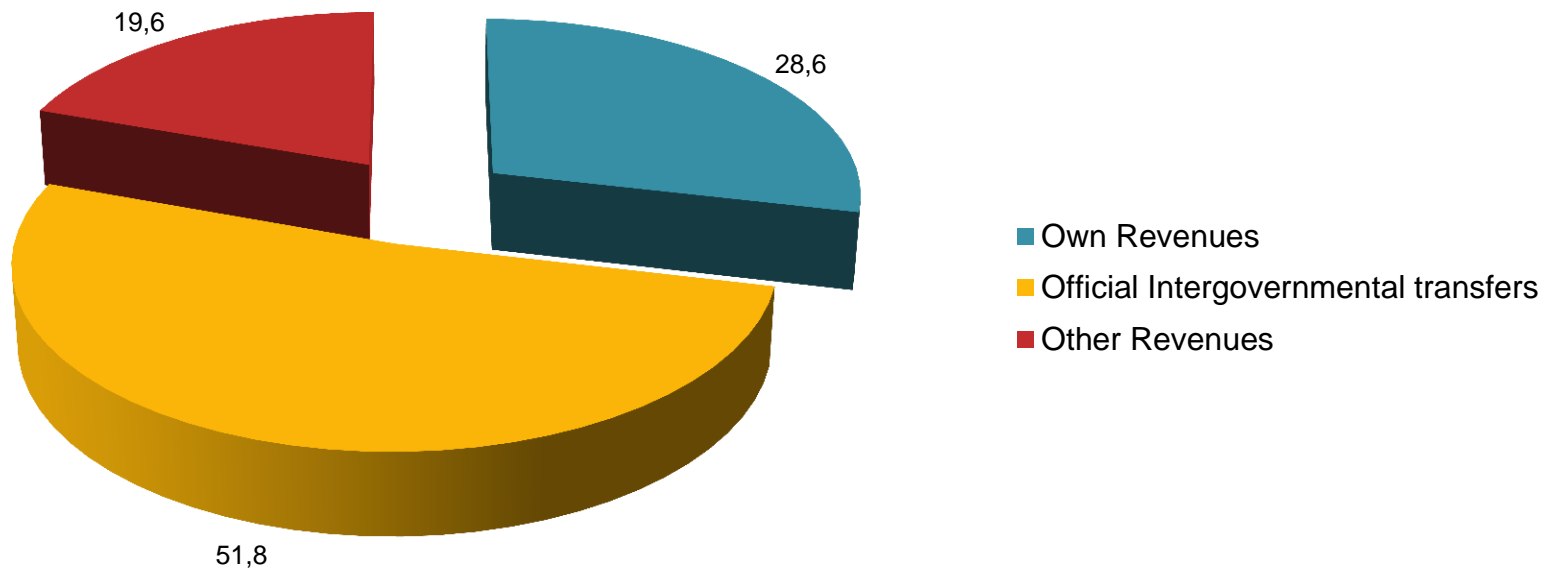
# Local Budget Revenues: Administrative Budget

1. Tax revenues
  - local taxes (land tax and property tax)
  - shares from state taxes and mandatory payments
  - penalties and fines.
2. Charges, which include state and local ones.
3. Official intergovernmental transfers (subsidies and financial equalization grants)
4. Other revenues (land and property leasing, local fees, etc. )
5. Deficit funding resources (credits from the state budget and/or other municipalities, unused revenues of the administrative budget from the beginning of the year).

# Local Budget Revenues: Capital Budget

1. Official transfers (subsidies),
2. Deficit funding resources (loans from the state budget and other sources),
3. Other revenues (unused revenues of the capital budget from the beginning of the year, as well as allocations to the capital budget from the reserved funds of the administrative budget, etc.)

# Ongoing Reforms

- Consolidation of municipalities
- New financial equalization system (more attention to smaller/weaker municipalities, consideration of expenditure needs)
