

• Participation ladder (Arnstein, 1969)





3 myths of participatory planning

Project abbreviation = date - location - Title



• Myths: Public authority vs citizens process

stakeholder engagement: departments in the same institutions, related public institutions, schools, hospitals, companies, NGOs etc.



• Implications and utility:

Educate collaboration and joint-work Empower institutions and organizations



• Myths: participation depends strictly on will & openness

Participation requires will, openness, resources (time, budgets, know-how) and patience.



Implications:

- Good tendering is a prerequisite for stakeholder participation: feasible timelines & deadlines, specify requirements etc;
- Budgeting: going out of your office for fieldwork, interviews, meetings implies extra workhours and specific skills.



 Myths: stakeholder engagement is a necessary hurdle, with largely non-monetary benefits

Stakeholder engagement, or rather stakeholder engagement, is all about resource mobilization: funds, implementing capacity, assets.



Implications and utility:

- Multiplier effect in resource mobilization
- Not just "mayor's" strategy / plan but "our community" strategy/plan



• HOW to DO STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

Define objectives of engagement:

- to do a good plan/strategy
- + to educate stakeholders on what a good plan/strategy is
- + ensure support and contribution in implementation

Meet, discuss, interview, survey ...

Show how you have used inputs, not just met people for the sake of it



Create the context for stakeholders to exchange ideas and views community issues

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Ask for direct input from stakeholders on needs and oportunities

Get advice from stakeholders (potential users) on what can be done

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Make sure mayor/local councillors are present.

Involve in prioritizing
