#### **Management by Objectives**

Identification of **common goals** and each others individual's major areas of responsibility

#### **Management by Exceptation**

Focus on identifying and handling **cases** that **deviate from the norm** 

#### **Management by Delegation**

**Delegation** of tasks, competences and responsibilities
