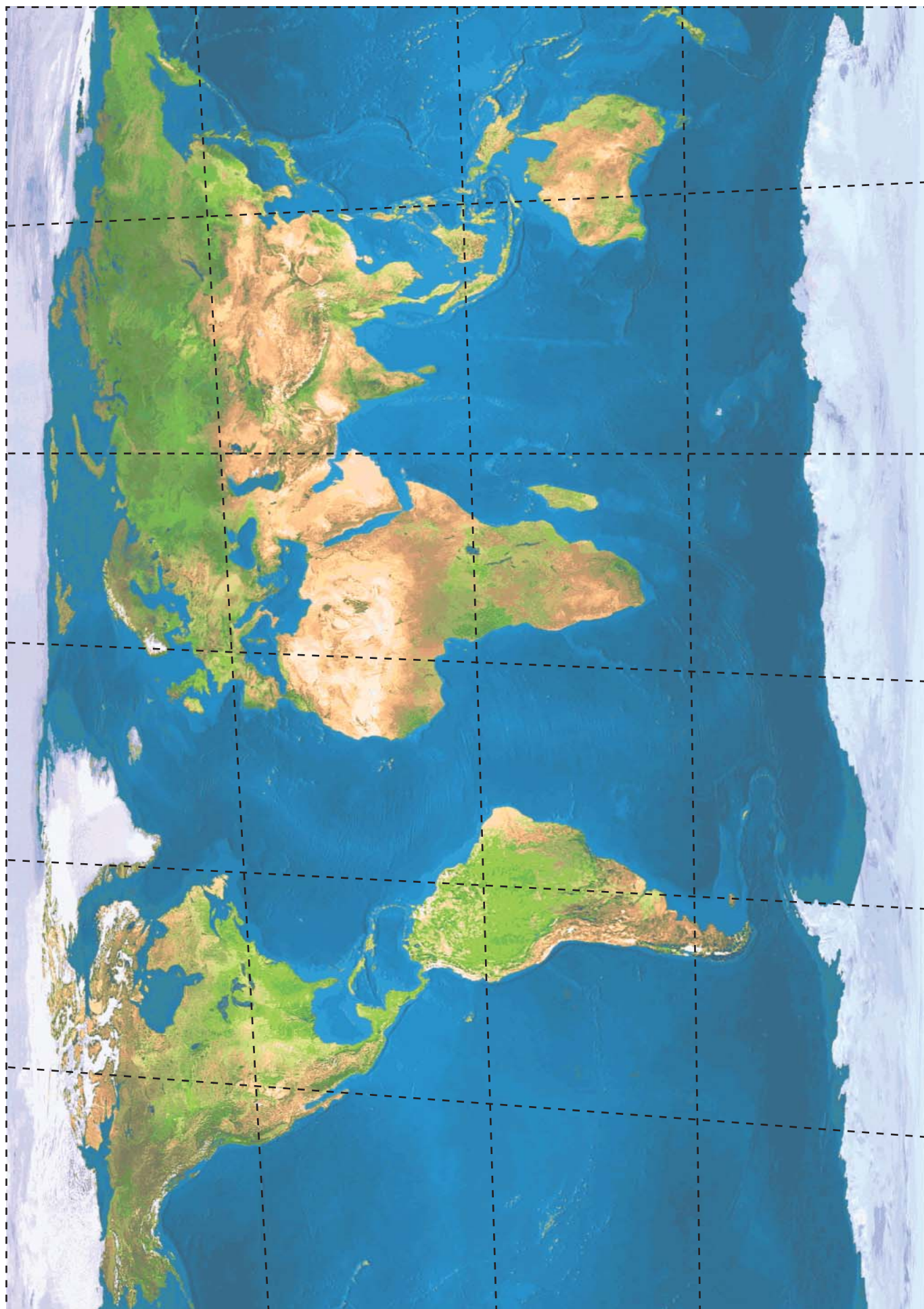
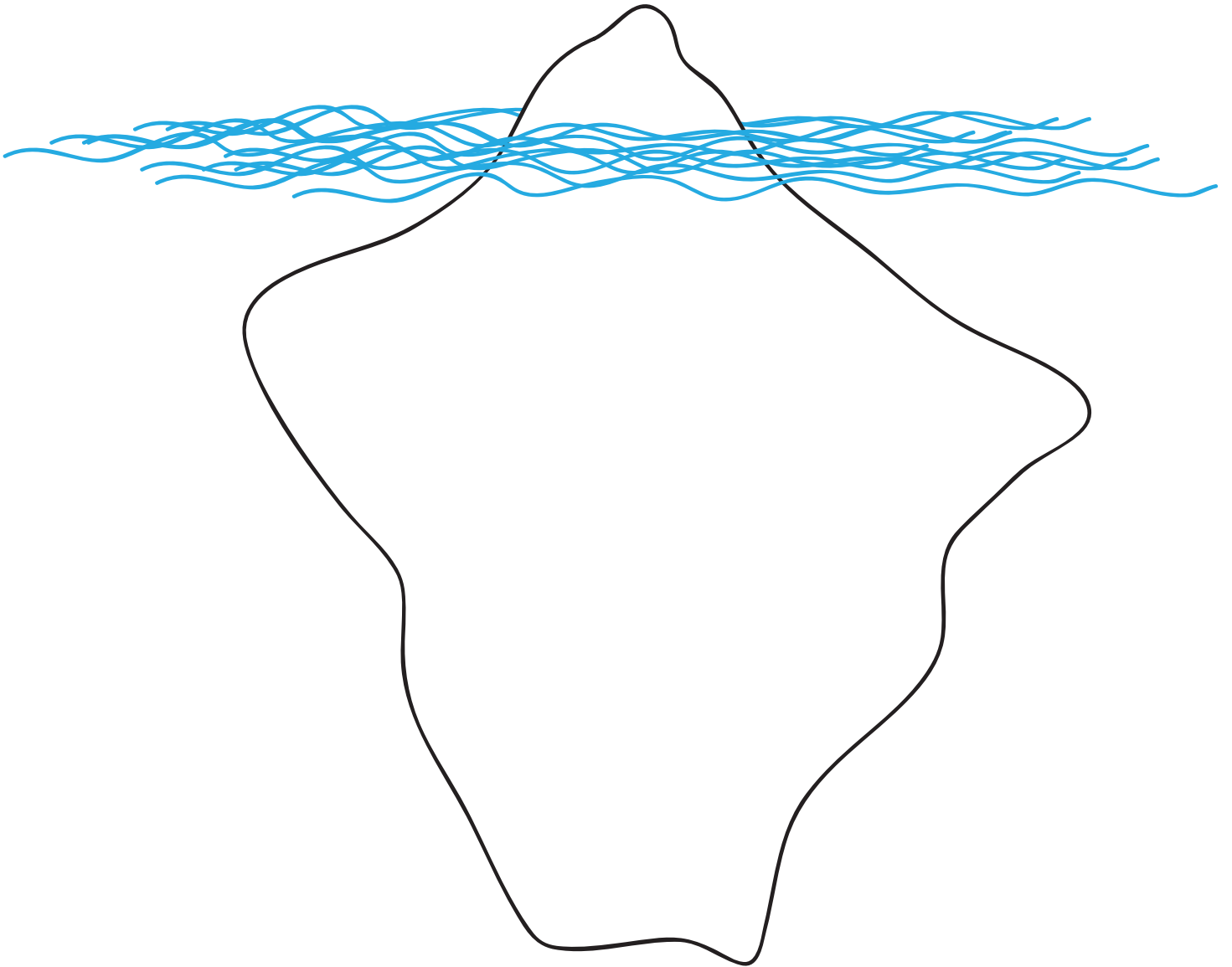


Appendix 1.1 - MAP OF THE WORLD FOR THE “PIECES OF THE WORLD” ACTIVITY

- WAS A POLITICAL PRISONER DURING 1970 - 1972

- AMERICAN ENTREPRENEUR, INVESTOR, STOCKBROKER, MOTIVATIONAL SPEAKER, AUTHOR, AND PHILANTHROPIST

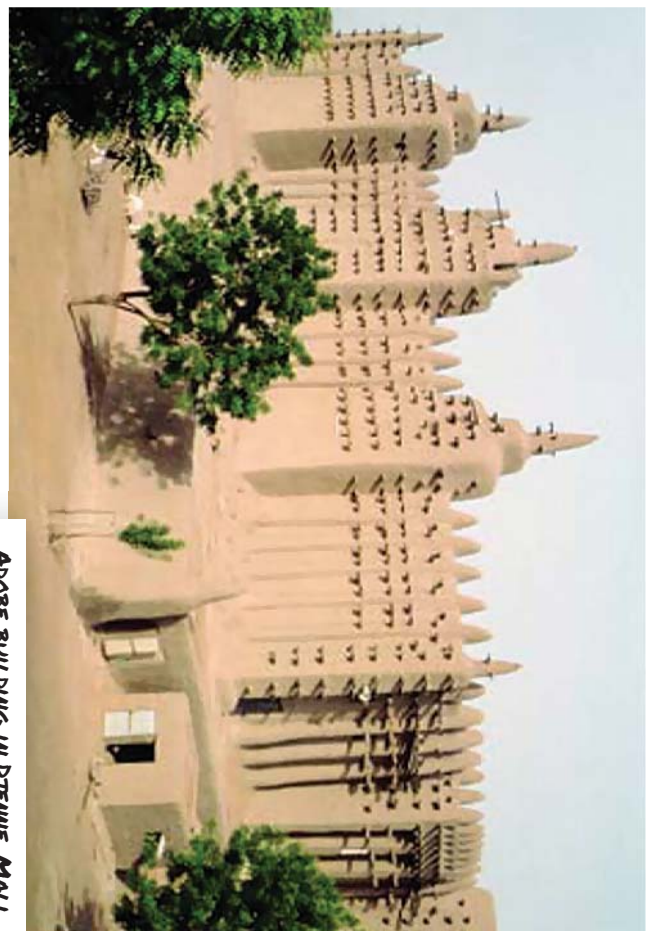

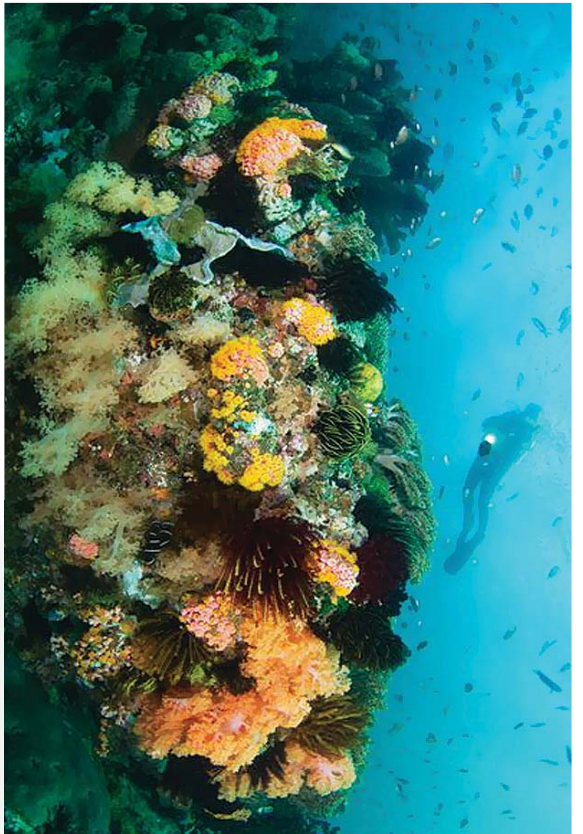

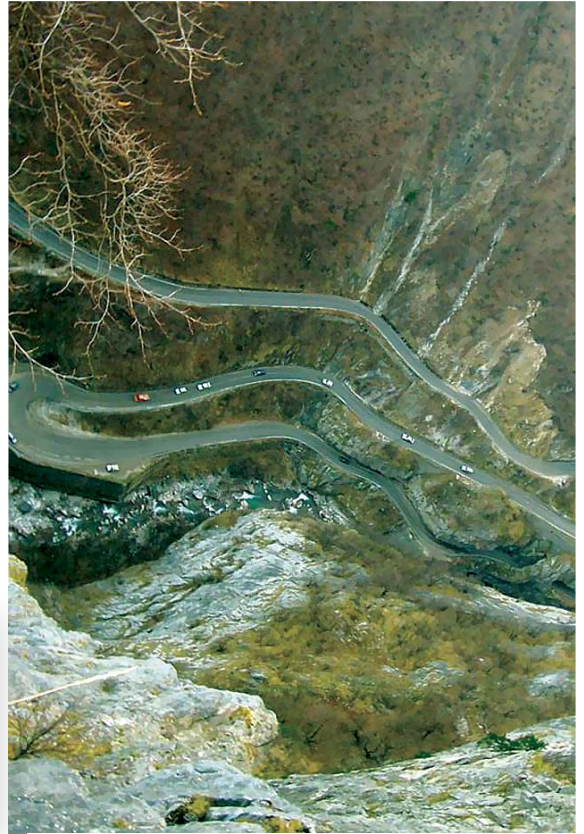

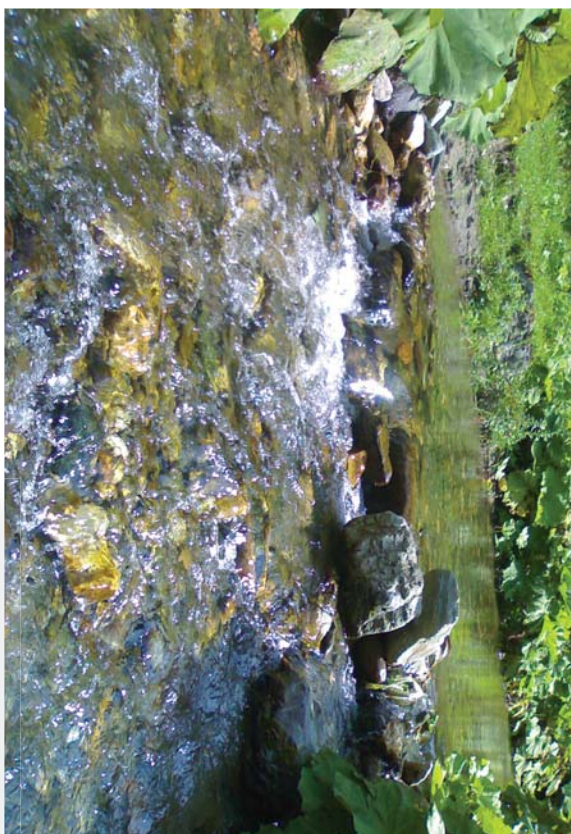
