### Introduction

This report provides an overview of the exception made in the territory of the European Union by the EU Member States during 2011-2012. The document is based on the national reports on derogations issued under Article 9 of the Birds Directive and Article 16 of the Habitats Directive, submitted to the European Commission by the Member States.

Please note that the following table gives an overview of the availability of national reports but does not provide any assessment of their contents. This biennial report is extracted from the 2009-2014 overview tables published on the Knowledge and Data page<sup>1</sup> of the Nature and Biodiversity webpage of by DG Environment for the derogations under the Birds Directive<sup>2</sup> and the Habitats Directive<sup>3</sup>.

### How to use the table

The table provides links to the folders in Reportnet that include the specific national reports. To visualize the reports please click on the files included in the folder. Then to visualize them in a readable form click on the HTML version. In some cases the reports were included in other formats but are still visible. If something does not work try changing browser, Mozilla and Explorer visualize Reportnet differently. In some cases the folders include additional information in other formats.

In principle each report should indicate in the title and in the "period" field the year of the reporting exercise (in which the derogations were actually active). In a few reports this approach has not followed.

In some cases there are old versions or wrong reports. The links included in this table are the ones indicated as correct by the national authorities.

### **Formats:**

Habides 2.10 was the reporting tool used till 2015. Files produced with Habides 2.10 are accessible directly online in HTML and can be converted in Excel tables of different kinds using the Habides 2.10 tool. A few reports (mainly older ones) do not follow the appropriate format but this problem has been progressively reduced.

In 2015 the Habides 2.10 reporting tool was been substituted with Habides+. The reporting exercise of 2015 covering reports for 2014 of the Birds Directive and 2013-14 for the Habitats Directive was still a transitional period and consequently some reports use the new tool and some the old one. Reports produced with Habides+ can be accessed directly online in HTML or in Excel.
