Revised Action Plan for 2016-2017

The draft Framework programme on Co-operation in the field of youth policy for 2016-2020 between the Ministry of Youth and Sports of Ukraine and the Council of Europe's Youth Department foresees three main areas of cooperation:

- Education for human rights and democratic citizenship (including youth participation, democratic governance, human rights education, etc.);
- Support to youth work development and recognition of non-formal education;
- Peace-building and intercultural dialogue.

The application of these objectives into a programme of activities for 2016-2017 is the object of the current document which takes into account:

- The experience of the 2015 activities and the needs related to their follow-up;
- The discussions in the Evaluation and Planning meeting held in Kyiv in March 2015;
- The proposals made by youth representatives, during the Study visit of a delegation of the Joint Council on Youth to Ukraine in September 2015;
- The results of negotiations between Council of Europe Youth Department and the Youth Department of Ministry of Youth and Sports of Ukraine;
- The decisions of the Programming Committee on Youth on the 2016 programme;
- The provisions of the Council of Europe Action Plan for Ukraine 2015-2017,
- The implementation of the youth dimensions of the Council of Europe thematic Action plans: No Hate Speech Movement campaign (Action plan on the fight against violent extremism and radicalisation leading to terrorism), Roma Youth Action Plan (Action Plan on Roma), Enter! Project and the Council of Europe Recommendation to the member states on the access of young people from disadvantaged neighbourhoods to social rights, adopted by the Committee of Ministers in January 2015 (Action Plan for Social Cohesion).

The finalisation and adoption of the present Action plan should be done at the first meeting of the Management Committee of the Framework Programme on Co-operation.

The implementation of the activities in Ukraine will remain being led by the Ministry of Youth and Sport who may delegate administrative and logistic tasks to other partners or associate them to the implementation of the activities.

In addition to the 2016-2017 Action Plan activities, the partners are encouraged, and committed to, taking part in other relevant activities, notably those organised in the European Youth Centres and those organised by the Ukrainian partners.

The funding required for the implementation of the activities is will be determined by each of the parties in the respect of each other's budgetary and administrative procedures and safeguarding the role of the co-management bodies of the Council of Europe youth sector. Co-funding of specific activities by third parties may be agreed by both parties.
