Drafting process

- Task Force meetings (c. 25 participants)
 - ✓ Meetings in December 2015, March 2016, June 2016
 - ✓ Written comments from Task Force Participants April 2016
- Internal consultations April 2016
 - √ 9 written comments from within the Council of Europe
- Public external consultations May 2016
 - √ 16 written comments (NGOS, International organisations, member States)
- Member State consultations June-July 2016
 - √ 12 written comments from Member States
- Additional consultations on French language version on terminology etc.

Strategy

- ✓ Strategy, not legally binding. No new legal obligations to member States.
- ✓ The goal is to achieve equality, dignity and equal opportunities for persons with disabilities.
- ✓ Guidance and inspiration to member States and other stakeholders on policies, activities and measures to ensure implementation of UNCRPD at national and local levels.
- √The interpretation and implementation of priority areas will be done in line with the UNCRPD

Priority Areas

- Rights based priority areas of the Council of Europe in disability field for the period from 2017 to 2023:
 - 1. Equality and non-discrimination (UNCRPD Art. 5-7)
 - 1. Awareness raising (UNCRPD Art. 8)
 - 1. Accessibility (UNCRPD Art. 9 and 21)
 - 1. Equal Recognition before the law (UNCRPD Art. 12)
 - 1. Freedom from exploitation, violence and abuse (UNCRPD Art. 16)

Cross-cutting issues

- Cross-cutting issues to be taken into consideration in all the work within Council of Europe and on national and local levels :
 - ✓ Participation, co-operation and coordination
 - ✓ Universal Design and reasonable accommodation
 - ✓ Gender equality perspective
 - Multiple discrimination
 - ✓ Education and training

Implementation

- a "twin-track" approach.
 - specific projects, campaigns, training, activities etc. organised at the national and local levels by national stakeholders in the member States.
 - mainstreaming disability related issues in all the work and activities of the Council of Europe.

Co-operation

- co-operation and exchange of good practices between
 - √ Council of Europe
 - ✓ Member States
 - √ the government representatives to the CAHDPH
 - ✓ national focal points, coordination mechanisms and independent frameworks, as they are established nationally under Article 33 of the UNCRPD
 - ✓ the civil society and other national and local actors
 - ✓ International and regional organisations

Follow up

- biennial reports on the implementation of the Strategy to the Committee of Ministers to include
 - ✓ recommendations by the independent monitoring mechanisms and various other structures within the Council of Europe,
 - ✓ relevant case-law of the European Court of Human Rights,
 - √ disability rights related events, campaigns and publications,
 - ✓ legislative and structural developments at the international, regional, national and local levels.
