# **DECISIONS**

At its 42<sup>nd</sup> Plenary Meeting (Strasbourg, 11-15 May 2009), the Group of States against Corruption (GRECO):

1. adopted the agenda as it appears in the Summary Report of the meeting (Greco (2009) 10E);

#### Information

2. took note of the information provided by the President and the Executive Secretary (cf. the Summary Report of the meeting - Greco (2009) 10E);

#### Third Evaluation Round

- 3. adopted the Third Round Evaluation Reports on:
  - Spain (Greco Eval III Rep (2008) 3E Themes I and II),
  - Belgium (Greco Eval III Rep (2008) 8E Themes I and II) and
  - Albania (Greco Eval III Rep (2008) 7E Themes I and II);
- 4. invited the authorities of Spain, Belgium and Albania to authorise, as soon as possible, the publication of the reports mentioned in decision 3 above;

#### Joint First and Second Evaluation Rounds

- 5. adopted the Joint First and Second Round Compliance Report on Ukraine (Greco RC I/II Rep (2009) 1E);
- 6. invited the authorities of Ukraine to authorise, as soon as possible, the publication of the report mentioned in decision 5 above;

#### Second Evaluation Round

- 7. adopted the Second Round Compliance Report on Georgia (Greco RC-II (2008) 9E);
- 8. invited the authorities of Georgia to authorise, as soon as possible, the publication of the report mentioned in decision 7 above;
- 9. adopted the Addenda to the Second Round Compliance Reports on:
  - Belgium (Greco RC-II (2006) 9E Addendum);
  - Denmark (Greco RC-II (2007) 2E Addendum);
  - France (Greco RC-II (2006) 12E Addendum) and
  - Slovenia (Greco RC-II (2006) 1E Addendum II);
- 10. invited the authorities of Belgium, Denmark and Slovenia to authorise, as soon as possible, the publication of the reports mentioned in decision 9 above;
- 11. noted with satisfaction that the authorities of France authorise the publication of the report mentioned in decision 9 above;

### Exchange of views

12. held an exchange of views with Mr François VINCKE, Chair of the Anti-Corruption Commission, International Chamber of Commerce and agreed that opportunities for intensified cooperation between the two bodies would be explored;
