- 1. Procedural dimension
- Three main mechanisms to preserve impartiality
- <u>due process clause</u> / right to natural judge, right to impartial judge/
- disqualification rules / based on presumption of impartiality until it is according to letter of the law or proved in the case shown that impartiality of a judge is endangered/
- <u>rules of procedure</u> / rules which have to be followed as condition to legitimate and lawful decision

- Mechanisms of judicial removal / disciplinary offences- Crucial is who can initiate proceedings, who is deciding on responsibilities of judges/
- Mechanisms of Judicial selection / which authority appoints judges, criteria for appointment/
- <u>Mechanisms for creating conditions for judges /</u> salaries, jurisdiction, budgets, administration /
- Purpose to promote public confidence in the judiciary./ If intentions are honest/

Introduction -4

- Two Codes exist
- First was created in 1998. by Association of Croatian Judges- only
- Structure- Principles and Explanatory Notes for implementation of the Code
- Applicable only to the Member of the Associationlimited effect
- Body responsible for application of the Code- Ethical Council

Croatian Experiance-1

- New Code of Ethic- 2006.
- Legal ground- Law on Courts /Article 107./
- Scope- all judges of all courts
- Body empowered to deliver it- Council composed of presidents of all Judges 'Councils /JC/.
- Role of JC- composition, authority, election procedure for membership, president of CJ

- Don't fear reversal
- There are no insignificant cases
- Be prompt
- Common sense
