Vision is an independent controlling manifestation of corruption.



2. Provision of the information about a person seeking or holding office at a state or municipal agency or enterprise; also about a person whose candidacy to EU or other international institution is recommended by Lithuania

Provision of the information about persons



- 3. Provision of the information to the registers of public servants and legal entities
- 4. Public disclosure of detected instances of corruption

5. Education and awareness raising of the public

- Convincing the public that corruption is a threat;
- Developing total intolerance towards corruption;
- Promoting public intolerance towards corruption and active anti-corruption fight.

TOOLS OF ANTI-CORRUPTION EDUCATION AND AWARENESS RAISING

Targeted

Universal

(Promotion campaigns for society in media, public transport, advertisements, social actions)

Pupils

80% of schools have incorporated anti-corruption education in the curriculum.

Students/the youth

All higher education institutions have an integrated or separate anti-corruption education course.

Public servants

STT officials hold an annual average of 100 anti-corruption seminars attended by more than 3,000 state and local government officials.

Provision of the methodical assistance for the staff of state and municipal institutions performing the functions in the area of corruption prevention




Possibility STT on the request of person who appointed public servant to the holding position to provide information about public servant's loyalty to the State, resistance to corruption or suitability for the position held.



Senior expert's rights and obligations:

- 1. To organize analysis of the data and conclusions written in the inspection certificate, assessment of their appropriateness and fairness, damage to the Health insurance budget, examination results of the process;
- 2. to deal with all the contentious issues which appear during the expertise process;
- 3. To require additional material and data from the inspected office;
- 4. To set the date of the meeting for the outcomes of the inspection;
- 5. If the examination was carried out by two persons, to decide on the final examination reports.
